**GAMING AND BETTING (POKER MACHINES) TAXATION
FURTHER AMENDMENT BILL, 1970**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to provide that supplementary license tax shall not be payable where aggregate net revenue derived by a club from the keeping, use or operation of poker machines during a period of twelve months is \$20,000 or less and shall be payable on a reduced scale where such aggregate net revenue is more than \$20,000 but less than \$40,000;
- (b) to provide that supplementary license tax of \$5,000 shall be payable where aggregate net revenue derived by a club from the keeping, use or operation of poker machines during a period of twelve months is \$40,000 or more but not more than \$41,200.
