[Assented to, 16th November, 1970.]

WHEREAS the Australian Loan Council at its ninety-eighth Preamble. meeting held on the twenty-sixth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and seventy, decided in pursuance of Clause 3 (9) of Part I of the Agreement set out in the schedule to the Financial Agreement
