GOVERNMENT GUARANTEES (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1968

EXPLANATORY NOTE

THE object of this Bill is to amend the Government Guarantees Act, 1934, as subsequently amended, to authorise the Treasurer to execute guarantees in respect of certain loans by approved lending institutions—

- (a) to dairy factories for purposes of acquiring facilities for bulk handling and transportation of milk; and
- (b) to the Trustees of The Labor Council of New South Wales for construction of certain buildings.

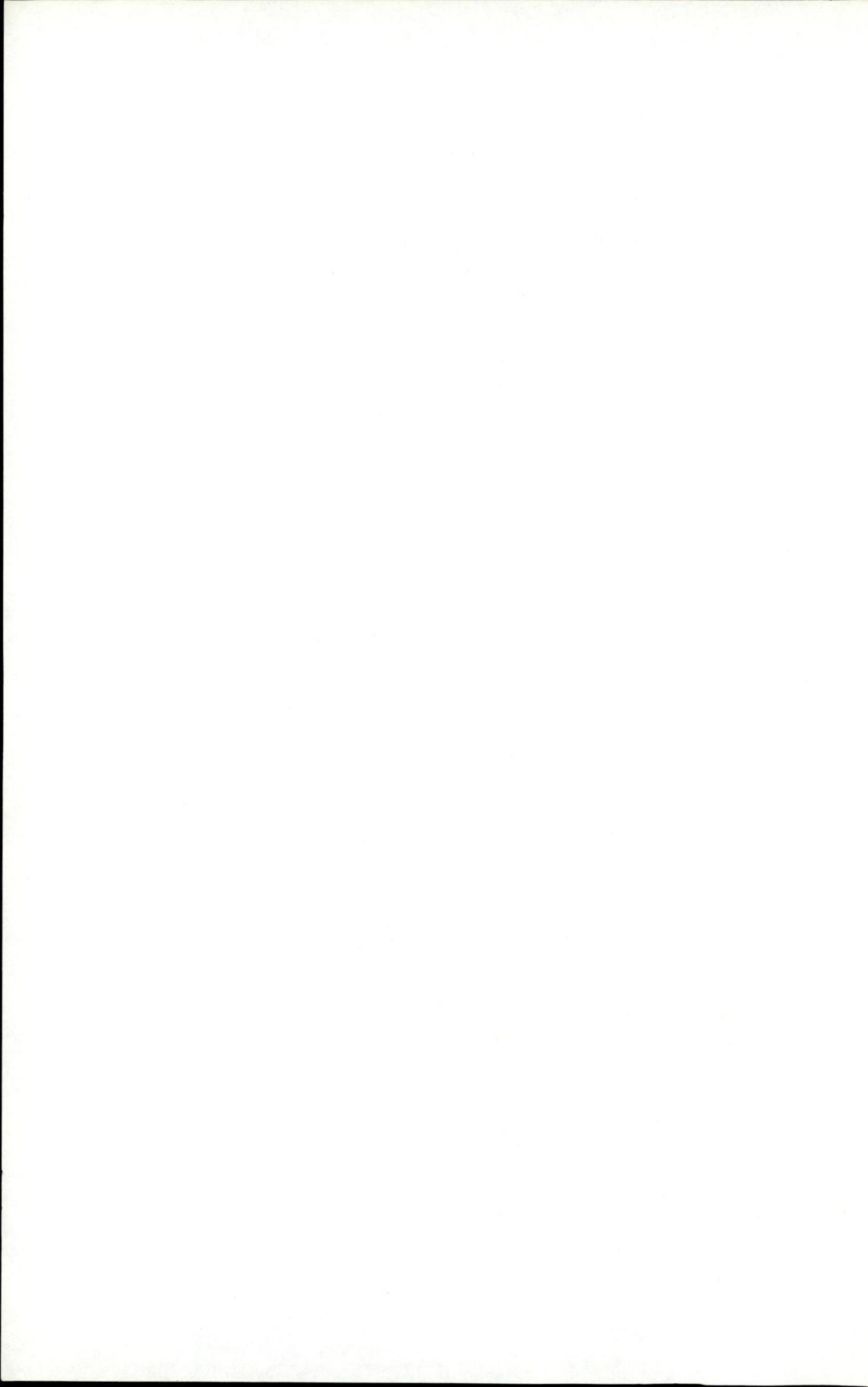
