LOCAL GOVERNMENT (REGULATION OF FLATS) AMENDMENT BILL, 1968

EXPLANATORY NOTE

THE Local Government (Regulation of Flats) Act, 1955, as subsequently amended, provides, inter alia, that the owner of any building erected before 30th June, 1949, may at any time before the expiration of thirteen years from the 13th December, 1955, apply to the council of the area in which the building is situated to convert the building into a residential flat building.

The object of this Bill is to extend, for a further five years, the period within which application as aforesaid may be made.

LOCAL COVERNMENT (REGULATION OF FLATS) AMENDMENT BILL, 1968

EXPLANATORY NOTE

THE Local Government (Regulation of Flats) Act, 1955, as subsequently amended. provides, inter alia, that the owner of any building erected before 30th June, 1949, may at any time before the expiration of thirteen years from the 13th December, 1955, apply to the council of the area in which the building is situated to convert the building into a residential flat building.
