**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Potato Growers Licensing (Amendment) Act, 1968".

(2) The Potato Growers Licensing Act, 1940–1965, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Potato Growers Licensing Act, 1940–1968.

(3) This Act shall commence upon a day to be appointed by the Governor and notified by proclamation published in the Gazette.

2. The Potato Growers Licensing Act, 1940–1965, is amended—

Sec. 3.  
(Application  
for license.)

(a) (i) by omitting from subsection two of section three the words "a fee of two dollars" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "the prescribed fee";

(ii) by omitting from the same subsection the words "Under Secretary" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "Director-General of Agriculture";

(b) by inserting at the end of section four the following new subsection :—

(5) To meet the cost of administration of this Act there shall be paid out of the special account to the credit of the Consolidated Revenue Fund in the year commencing on the first day of July, next following the commencement of this Act, and in each succeeding year commencing on the first day of July, an amount equal to ten per centum of the total sum paid to the credit of the special account during the preceding period of twelve months.
