
# PUBLIC SERVICE AND OTHER STATUTORY BODIES (EXTENDED LEAVE) AMENDMENT BILL, 1970

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

THE objects of this Bill are-

- (a) to grant additional extended leave to officers of the Public Service, the Water Conservation and Irrigation Commission, the Departments of Main Roads, Railways, Government Transport and Motor Transport, and to members of the Police Force;
- (b) to provide that those officers and members respectively who are dismissed from their employment for serious and wilful misconduct before completing ten years' service shall not be entitled to extended leave.

### A BILL

To provide additional extended leave for certain persons; to withdraw certain rights relating to extended leave from certain persons dismissed from their employment for serious and wilful misconduct; for these purposes to amend the Public Service (Amendment) Act, 1919, the Irrigation Act, 1912, the Main Roads Act, 1924, the Government Railways Act, 1912, the Transport Act, 1930, and the Police Regulation Act, 1899; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
