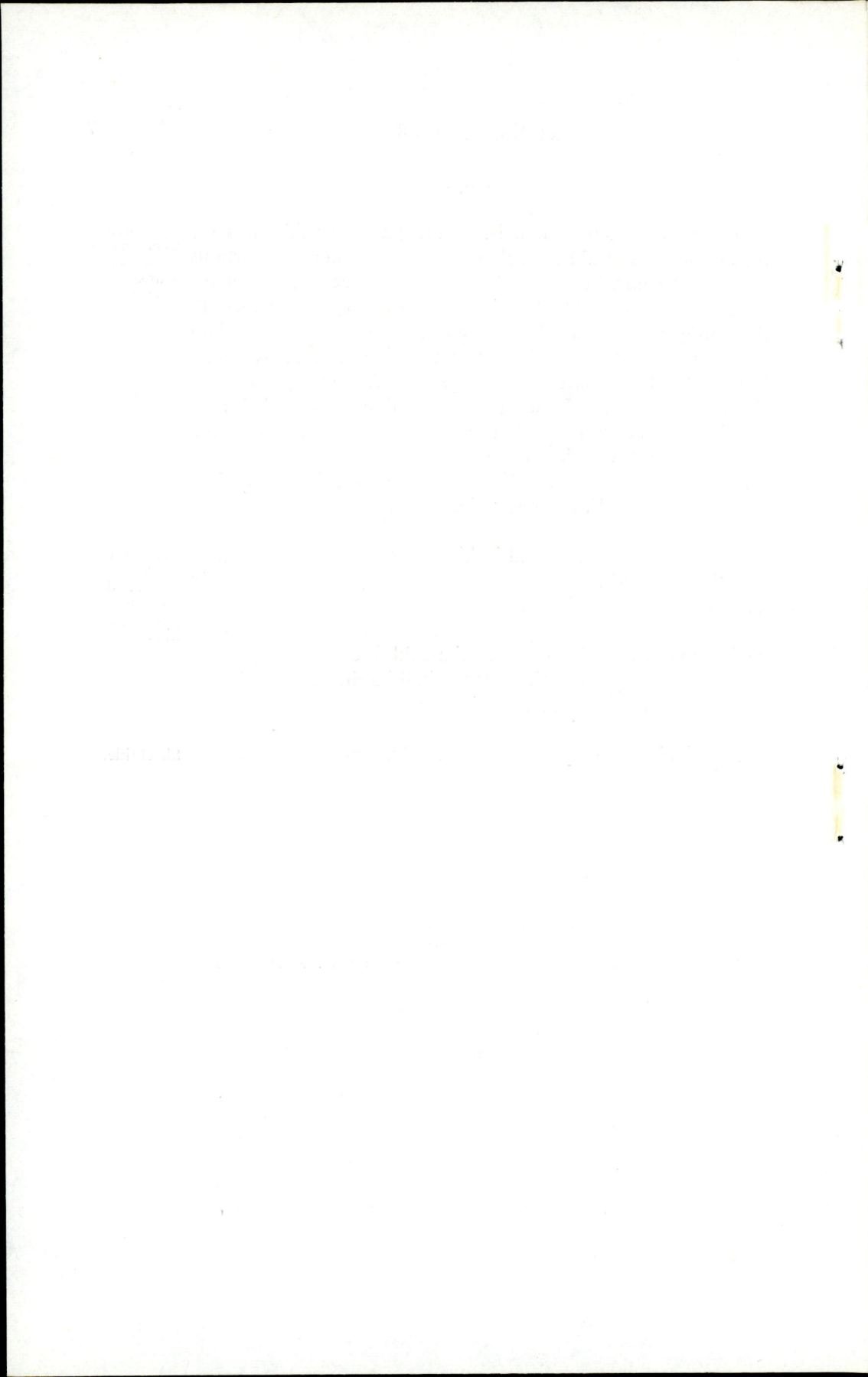

Out of the Maritime Services Board Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of Two million four hundred and thirty-five thousand dollars to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1968-1969.

Out of the Maritime Services Board Renewals Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of One million three hundred and forty-one thousand dollars to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1968-1969.

The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct.
