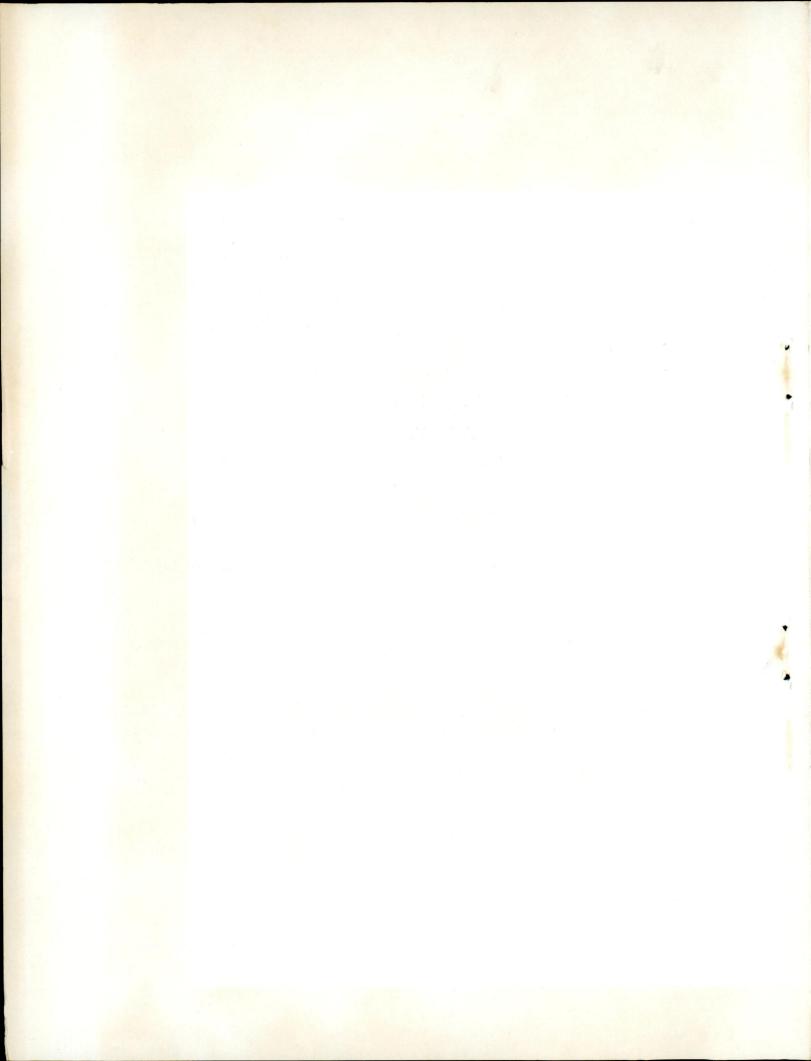

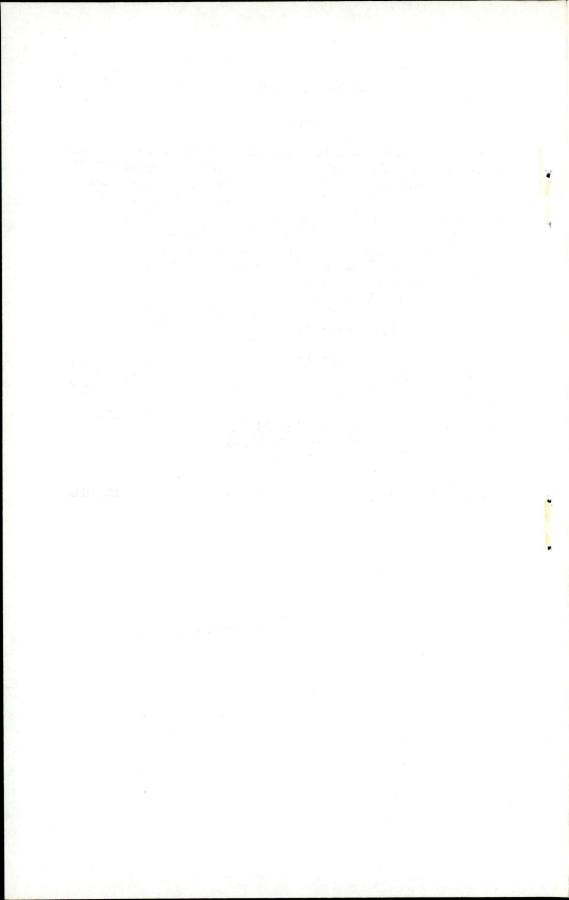

Out of the Government Railways Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of Thirty-two million three hundred and eleven thousand dollars to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Railways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixtynine, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1968–1969.

\$2,017,000 may be issued out of the Government Railways Renewals Fund.

3. Out of the Government Railways Renewals Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of Two million and seventeen thousand dollars to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department

of Railways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1968–1969.

4. Out of the Road Transport and Traffic Fund there shall \$2,485,000 and may be issued and applied for or towards making good issued out the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of the Road of Two million four hundred and eighty-five thousand dollars and Traffic to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the Fund. financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Motor Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1968-1969.

5. Out of the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund \$4,669,000 there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards issued out of making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her the Metro-Majesty, the sum of Four million six hundred and sixty-nine politan Transport thousand dollars to be expended at the rates which have been Trust sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, General Fund. one thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Government Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1968-1969.

6. Out of the Newcastle and District Transport Trust \$552,000 General Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for may be issued out or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted of the to Her Majesty, the sum of Five hundred and fifty-two Newcastle and District thousand dollars to be expended at the rates which have been Transport sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, General

one thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Government Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1968–1969.

\$2,435,000 may be issued out of the Maritime Services Board Fund.

7. Out of the Maritime Services Board Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of Two million four hundred and thirty-five thousand dollars to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1968–1969.

\$1,341,000 may be issued out of the Maritime Services Board Renewals Fund.

8. Out of the Maritime Services Board Renewals Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of One million three hundred and forty-one thousand dollars to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1968–1969.

The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for Treasurer the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions to pay under Governor's as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his Warrant hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to or Order. time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Government Railways Fund, the Government Railways Renewals Fund, the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, the Maritime Services Board Fund, and the Maritime Services Board Renewals Fund, respectively.

The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time Treasurer be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in to have credit and pursuance of such Warrants or Orders, and the receipts of receipts to the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall discharge him. be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

11. This Act may be cited as the "Supply Act, 1968."
