## **SURVEYORS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1968.**

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE.**

THE object of this Bill is to provide for the appointment by the Governor of the head or a professor or other member of a school of surveying conducted by The University of New South Wales, or some other prescribed university or other educational institution, to be an additional member of the Board of Surveyors.

A provision has also been included which provides that the office of a member of the board shall become vacant if such member ceases to hold the qualification by virtue of which he was appointed.

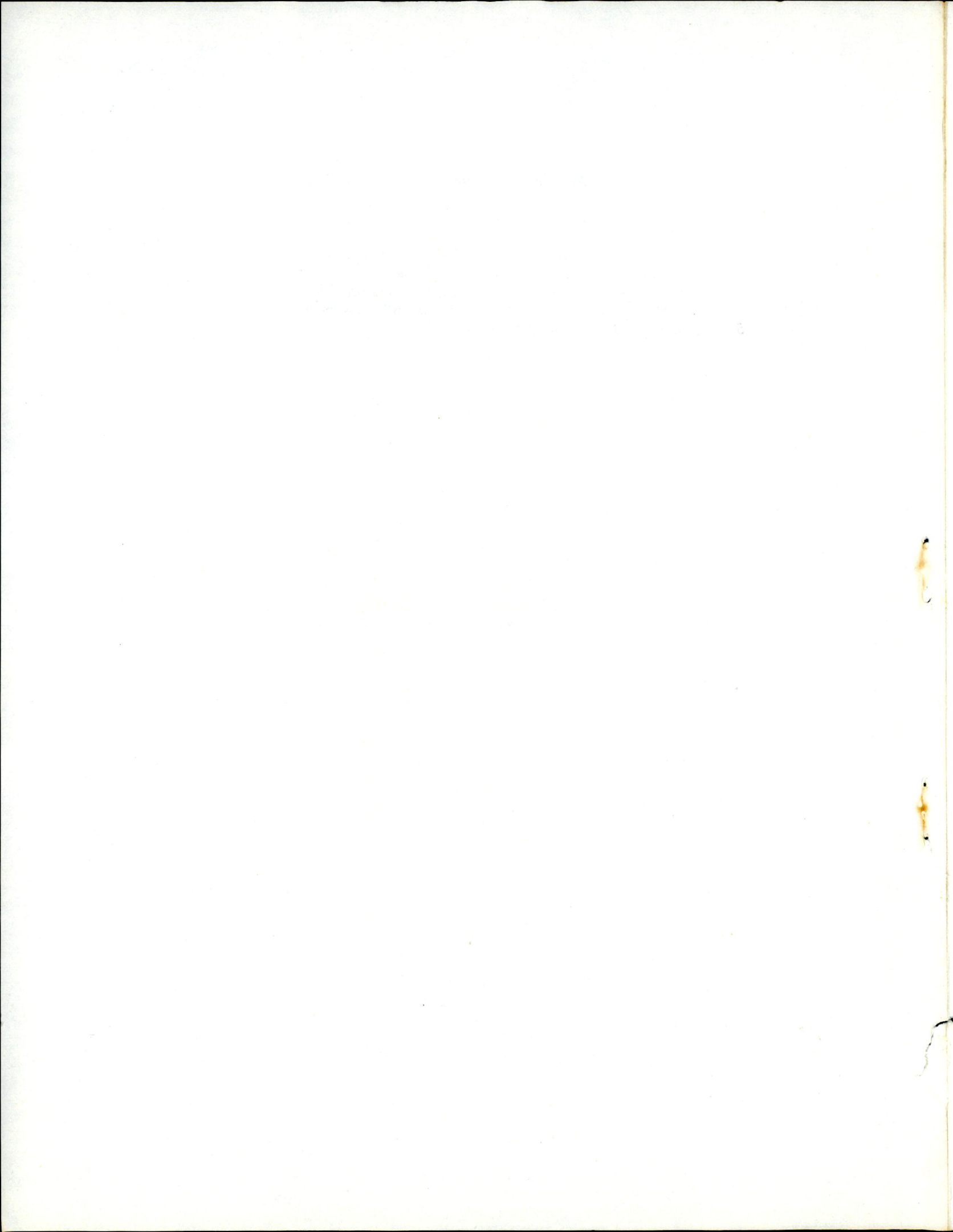
