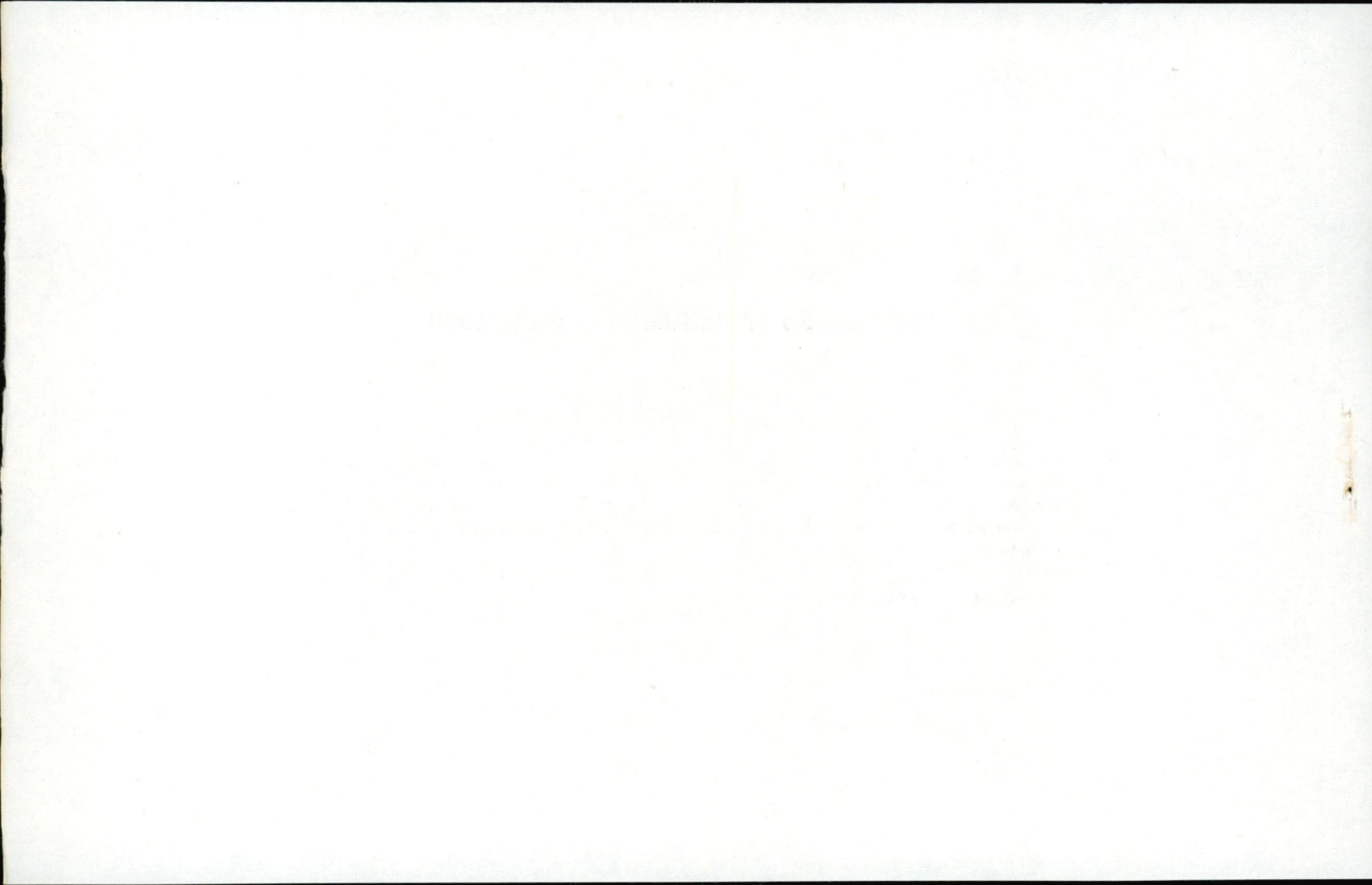

## **SURVEYORS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1969**

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

THE object of this Bill is to remove the requirement for the Governor to approve the scale of costs, issued by the Institution of Surveyors, New South Wales, Incorporated, to be applied by the Registrar of the Land and Valuation Court for the taxation of a bill, for any fee, charge or disbursement, delivered by a surveyor for work done by him as such surveyor.
