#### GENERAL.

37. (1) Subject to section thirty-four of the Audit Act, 1902, Variation of and subsection two of this section, expenditure shall not be incurred authorized on any item, subdivision, division, or vote, shown on the Estimates expenditure of the Consolidated Revenue Fund in excess of the sum provided from Con-solidated therefor on such Estimates.

(2) If the exigencies of the Public Service render it necessary, the Treasurer or person appointed by him may authorize the transfer of a specific amount from any item, subdivision, or division other than for specific public works or an item under the division "Other Services", to any other item, subdivision, or division, within the same vote other than for specific public works or an item under the division "Other Services"

38. (1) Subject to subsection two of this section, expenditure Variation of shall not be incurred on any division shown on the Estimates of authorized the Government Railways Fund, the Road Transport and Traffic expenditure Fund, the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the from other Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, and the Funds. Treasurer or lawful authority shall pay by warrant or order. 40. There shall be issued and paid the said several sums for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor by any warrant or order in writing under his hand and directed to the Treasurer or other lawful authority may from time to time order and direct, and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the said funds respectively; but the said Treasurer shall not be held liable for any claims which may arise in connection with any of the State Departments transferred to the Commonwealth on or after the date of such transfer.

Treasurer or lawful authority shall be allowed credit for moneys paid by them. 41. The said Treasurer or other lawful authority shall in their respective accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum or sums of money paid by him or them in pursuance of such warrant or order in writing as aforesaid, and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer or other lawful authority in passing the said accounts for any such sums as may be therein mentioned, and he or they shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
