An Act to make further provision with respect to the allotment of base quotas for the purposes of the Egg Industry Stabilisation Act, 1971; for this and other purposes to amend that Act; and for purposes connected therewith.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to enable base quotas to be allotted to certain persons who are not poultry farmers as defined in section 3 (1) of the Egg Industry Stabilisation Act, 1971;
- (b) to make provision permitting the allotment to persons who are Group I poultry farmers under that Act of base quotas in excess of their ordinary entitlements;
- (c) to deem a person who, on behalf of the estate of a deceased person who immediately before his death was the holder of a license, keeps hens to be the holder of that license;
- (d) to make other provisions of an ancillary or consequential nature.
