**W**HEREAS the Australian Loan Council at its one-hundredth meeting held on the sixteenth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and seventy-one, decided in pursuance of Clause 3 (9) of Part I of the Agreement set out in the schedule to the Financial Agreement Act, 1944, that the amount to be borrowed for the loan programmes of the Commonwealth and the States for housing and State works for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and seventy-two, shall be eight hundred and sixty million dollars, and by unanimous decision allocated an amount of two hundred and seventy-three million five hundred and thirty thousand dollars to the State of New South Wales, BE it enacted therefore by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:—

Preamble.

1. This Act may be cited as the "General Loan Account Appropriation Act, 1971".

2. The sum of three hundred and forty-one million four hundred and eighty-nine thousand dollars is hereby appropriated from the General Loan Account for the public works and services hereunder set out, and shall, as required, be applied as follows:—
