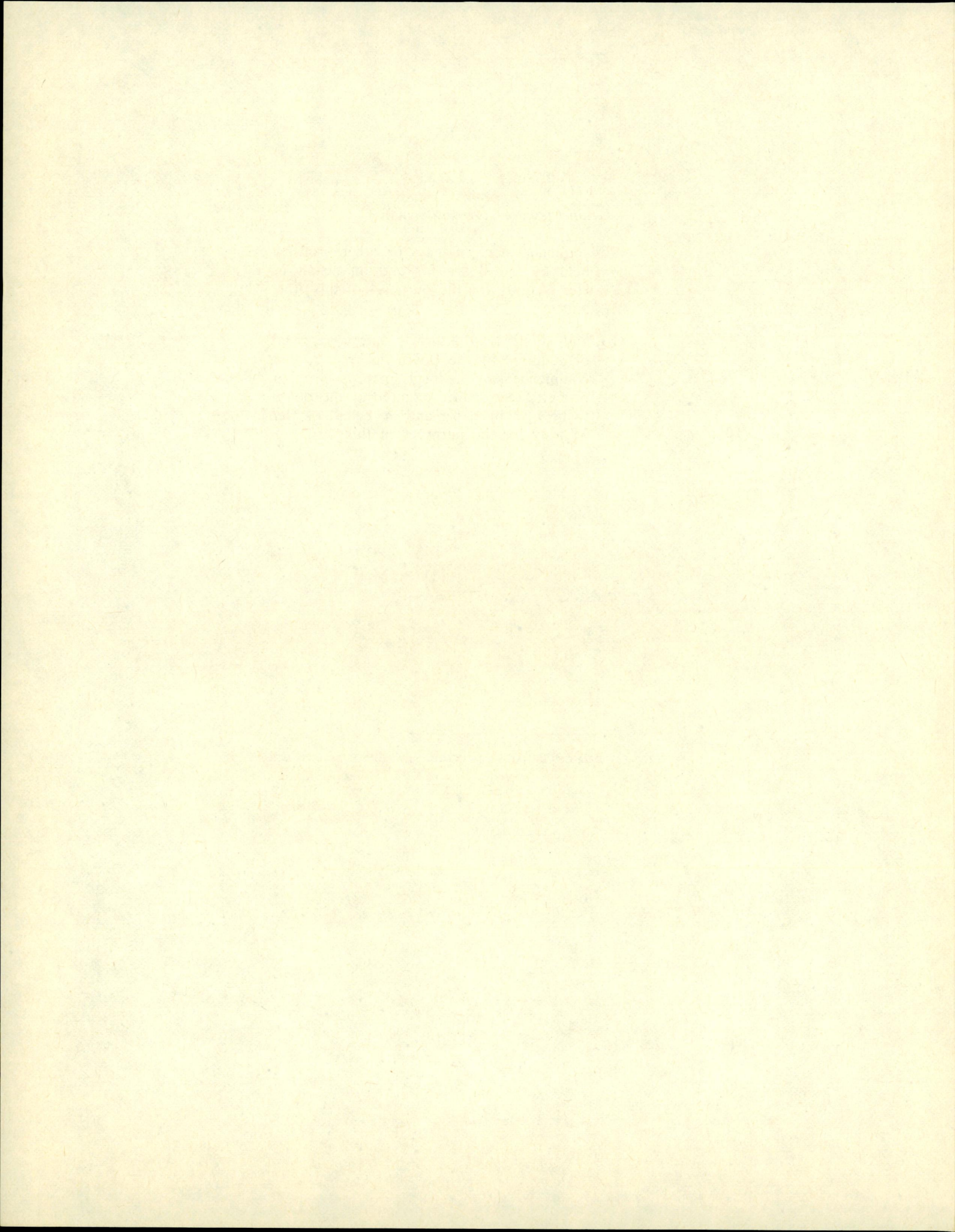

EXPLANATORY NOTE

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to enable the Grain Elevators Board of New South Wales to store and handle seed and products manufactured from plant material as well as wheat and grain other than wheat;
- (b) to provide that the Board shall hold, receive or acquire moneys and other property for and on behalf of Her Majesty; and
- (c) to make other provisions of a minor or ancillary nature.

ARTICLE 1

SECTION 1

1. The purpose of this Act is to provide for the better administration of the public lands of the State of California.

2. The State Lands Commission is hereby created, and its powers and duties are defined as follows: (a) to acquire, hold, manage, and dispose of public lands; (b) to lease public lands for public use; (c) to sell public lands for private use; (d) to grant mineral rights in public lands; (e) to grant water rights in public lands; (f) to grant other rights in public lands.

3. The State Lands Commission shall be composed of five members, to be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate.

4. The State Lands Commission shall have the honor and privilege of the rank of Major General in the State Militia.

5. The State Lands Commission shall have the honor and privilege of the rank of Lieutenant Colonel in the State Militia.

6. The State Lands Commission shall have the honor and privilege of the rank of Captain in the State Militia.

7. The State Lands Commission shall have the honor and privilege of the rank of Major in the State Militia.

8. The State Lands Commission shall have the honor and privilege of the rank of Lieutenant in the State Militia.

9. The State Lands Commission shall have the honor and privilege of the rank of Captain in the State Militia.
