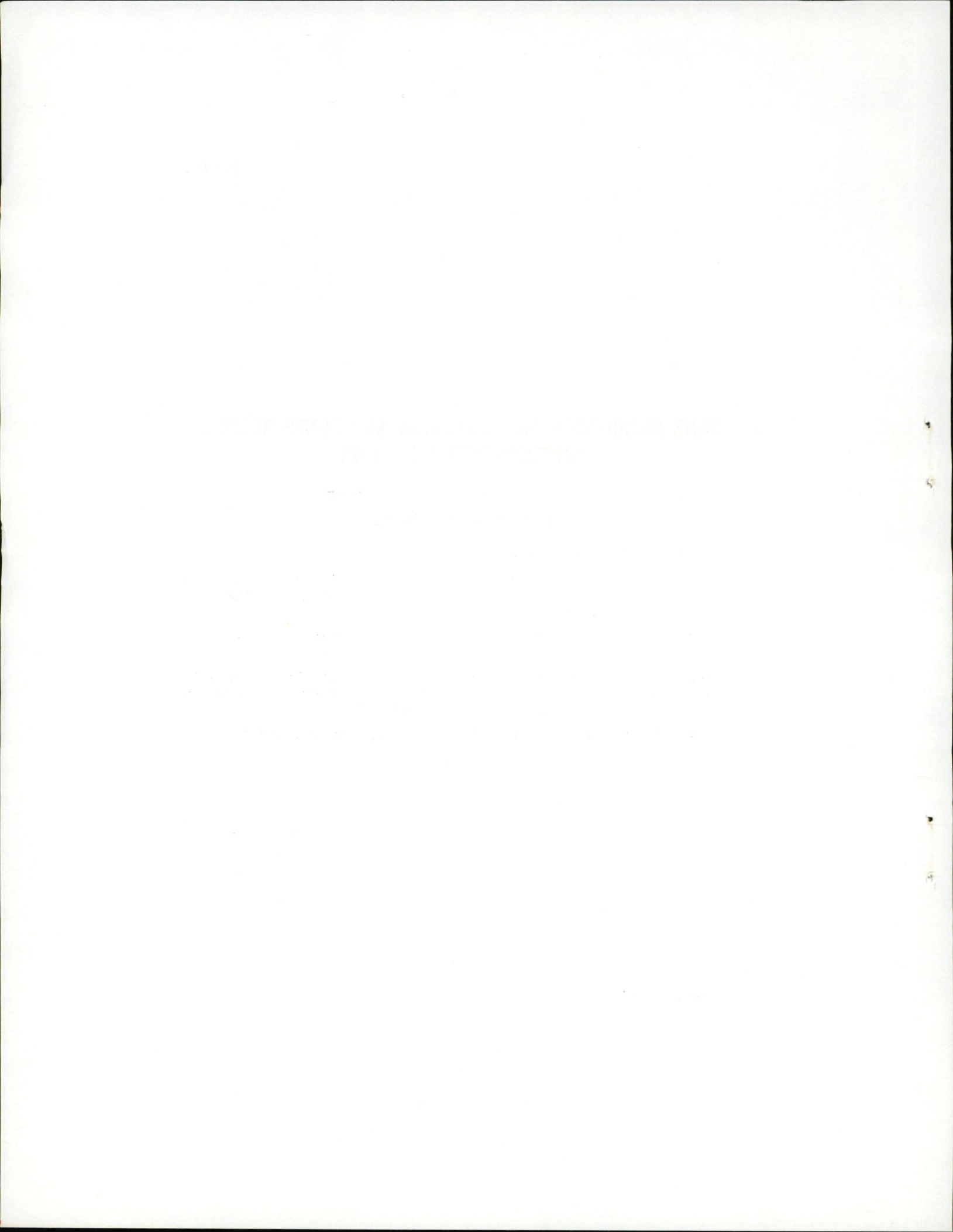

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

**THE** purposes of this Bill are to—

- (a) entitle employers of certain members of the Mine Subsidence Board and the Mines Rescue Board to receive the fees payable to those members in connection with their service as members;
- (b) entitle members of those Boards to be paid out-of-pocket and sustenance expenses incurred in connection with the business of the Boards;
- (c) authorise the use of Mine Subsidence Compensation Fund moneys for investigations into claims against the Fund for compensation and validate expenditure of this nature already incurred; and
- (d) make other provisions of a minor, consequential or ancillary nature.

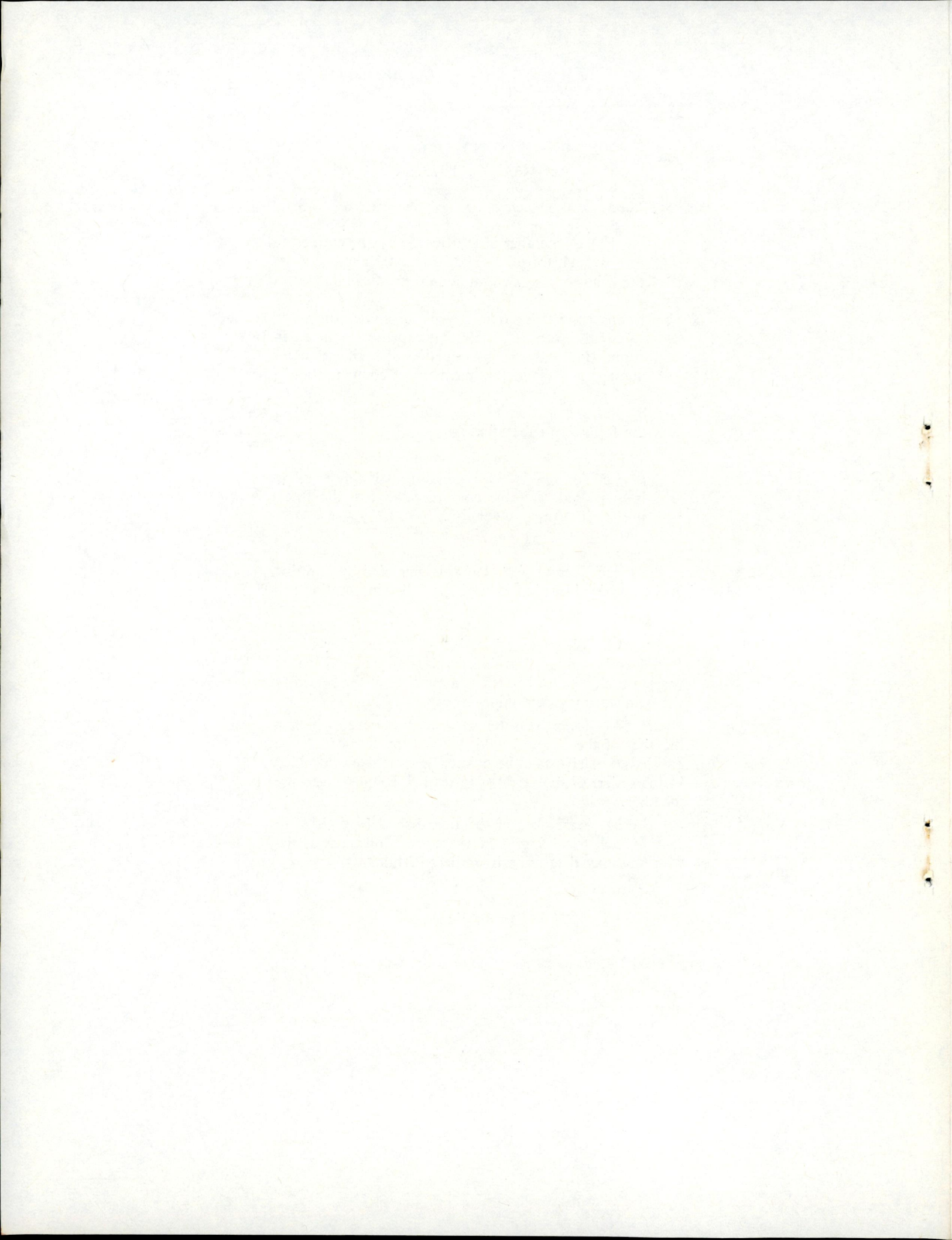

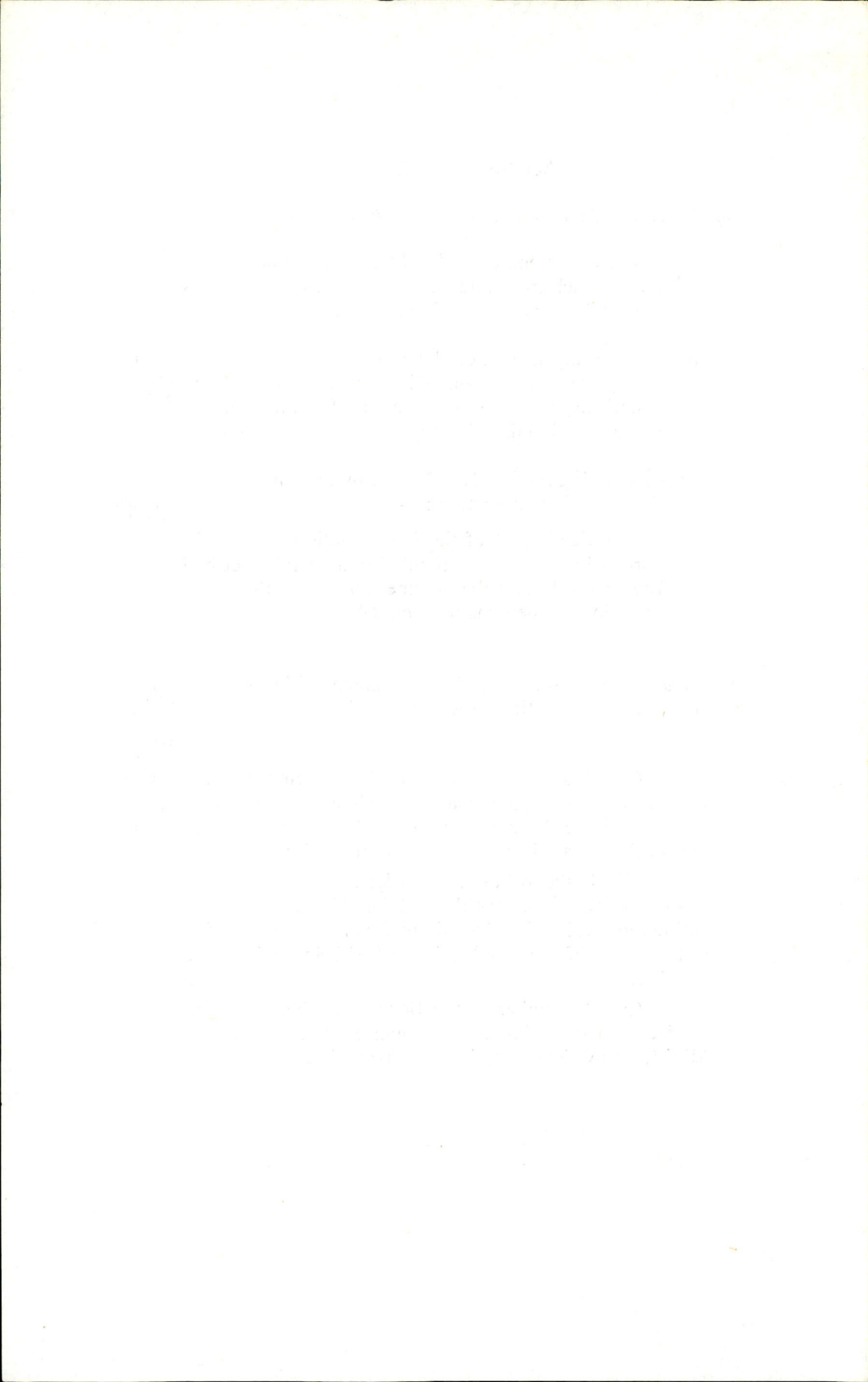
