The amendments made by paragraph (c) of section Application two of this Act shall apply to the person holding office as of amenddeputy chairman of the New South Wales Institute of incumbent Psychiatry at the commencement of this Act as if such person deputy were appointed to hold such office for a period of five years from the date of his appointment and at the expiration of the period of five years were eligible to be again appointed to hold office as deputy chairman.
