- (ii) by omitting from subsection four of the same section the words "not be eligible to be again appointed to hold office as deputy chairman within one year after the expiration of his last term of office as deputy chairman" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "be eligible to be again appointed to hold office as deputy chairman";
- (d) (i) by inserting in paragraph (b) of subsection two of section sixteen next before the words "any moneys" the words "except as provided by subsection seven of this section,"; Sec. 16. (New South Wales Institute of Psychiatry Account.)
- (ii) by inserting in subsection three of the same section after the word "thereof" the words "and the provisions of subsection ten of this section,";
- (iii) by inserting in subsection four of the same section after the word "may" the words ", subject to the terms of any trust or condition affecting those moneys or any part thereof";
- (iv) by inserting next after subsection five of the same section the following new subsections :—

(6) The Institute may establish such other accounts as it deems necessary for the purpose of maintaining, separate from the Account, accounts relating to property acquired by the Institute for any of the purposes of this Act on trust or subject to conditions affecting that property to which the Institute has agreed as referred to in section eighteen of this Act.

(7) There shall be placed to the credit of an account established under subsection six of this section such moneys as are received by the Institute in respect of the property to which the account relates.

(8)

(8) Where, prior to the commencement of the New South Wales Institute of Psychiatry (Amendment) Act, 1971, any moneys in the Account were received by the Institute in respect of property acquired by the Institute on trust or subject to any condition affecting that property to which the Institute has agreed as referred to in section eighteen of this Act, the moneys may, in lieu of being retained in the Account, be carried to a separate account established under subsection six of this section.

(9) Subject to subsection eleven of this section the moneys in an account established under subsection six of this section shall be applied in accordance with the trust or condition affecting the property to which such moneys relate.

(10) Any moneys in the Account not subject to a trust or a condition as referred to in section eighteen of this Act may be placed to the credit of any account established under subsection six of this section.

(11) The Institute may transfer any moneys placed to the credit of an account in accordance with subsection ten of this section from such account to the Account or any other account established under subsection six of this section.

(12) The Institute may, subject to the terms of any trust or condition affecting the property to which the account established under subsection six of this section relates, invest any moneys in such an account in any manner in which trustees are for the time being authorised to invest trust funds.

(13)

New South Wales Institute of Psychiatry (Amendment).

(13) Property that is subject to a trust by reason only of the provisions of section sixteen of this Act shall be deemed not to be subject to a trust for the purposes of this section.

3. The amendments made by paragraph (c) of section two of this Act shall apply to the person holding office as deputy chairman of the New South Wales Institute of Psychiatry at the commencement of this Act as if such person were appointed to hold such office for a period of five years from the date of his appointment and at the expiration of the period of five years were eligible to be again appointed to hold office as deputy chairman.
