### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

THE objects of this Bill are to amend the Regional Organisation Act, 1972, so as—

- (a) to enable the election or appointment of an officer, employee, member or servant of a Government Department or public authority as a local government or citizen representative on an advisory council;
- (b) to empower the convening of meetings of an advisory council otherwise than at the direction of the chairman of the council, as well as at his direction;
- (c) to provide for the appointment of a person to preside at a meeting of a committee of an advisory council in the absence of the chairman,

and to make other provisions of a consequential or ancillary character.


