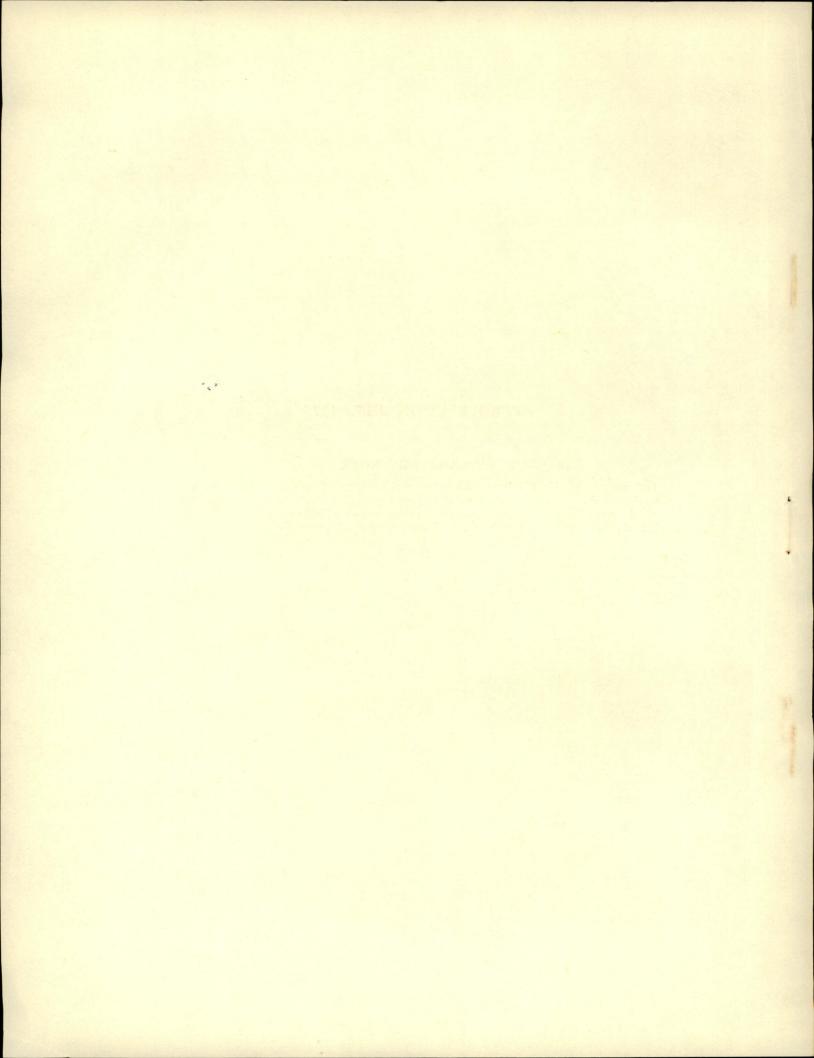
APPROPRIATION BILL, 1975

EXPLANATORY NOTE

THE purpose of this Bill is to appropriate various sums of money required for the service of the Government during the current financial year and also to appropriate certain expenditures of an unforeseen and urgent nature which were made during the financial year 1974–1975 without actual Parliamentary Appropriation.

A BILL

To appropriate out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, and certain other Funds, sums for the ordinary annual services of the Government for the year commencing on 1st July, 1975, and ending on 30th June, 1976, both dates inclusive, and for charges supplementary or "Unauthorized in Suspense" from certain Funds for the year from 1st July, 1974, to 30th June, 1975, both dates inclusive; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

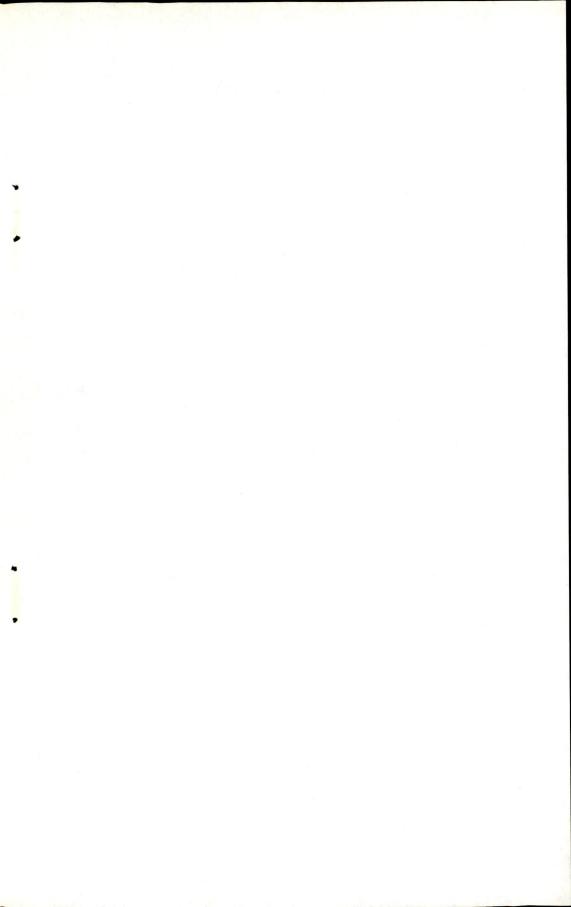

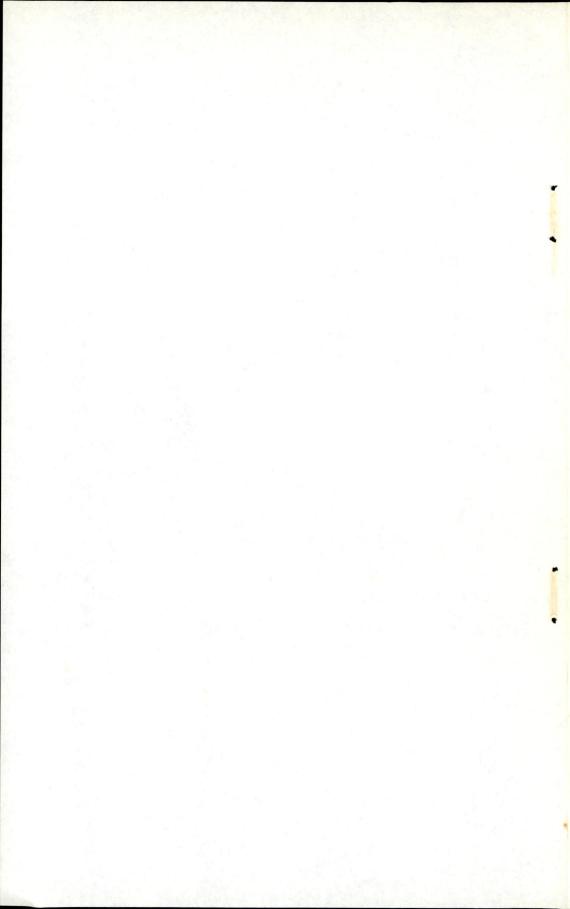

GENERAL.

35. (1) Subject to section thirty-four of the Audit Act, 1902, Variation of and subsection two of this section, expenditure shall not be incurred authorized on any item, subdivision, division, or vote, shown on the Estimates expenditure of the Consolidated Revenue Fund in excess of the sum provided from Consolidated therefor on such Estimates.

Revenue Fund.

- (2) If the exigencies of the Public Service render it necessary, the Treasurer or person appointed by him may authorize the transfer of a specific amount from any item, subdivision, or division other than for specific public works or an item under the division "Other Services", to any other item, subdivision, or division, within the same vote other than for specific public works or an item under the division "Other Services".
- 36. (1) Subject to subsection two of this section, expenditure Variation of shall not be incurred on any division shown on the Estimates of authorized the Government Railways Fund, the Road Transport and Traffic expenditure Fund, the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the from other Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, and the Funds. Maritime Services Board Fund, in excess of the sum provided therefor on such Estimates.

- (2) If the exigencies of the Public Service render it necessary, the Treasurer or the person appointed by him may authorize the transfer of a specific amount from any division, other than for specific public works, to any other division within the vote other than for specific public works.
- 37. (1) Nothing in sections thirty-five and thirty-six of this Act Provisions shall empower the Treasurer or the person appointed by him as affecting aforesaid to authorize the transfer of any sum in augmentation sections of or as an addition to any salary or wages the amount of which thirty-five and thirtyhas been fixed by law.
- (2) The Treasurer shall cause the Auditor-General to be informed of every authority granted pursuant to sections thirty-five and thirty-six of this Act.

Treasurer or lawful authority shall pay by warrant or order. 38. There shall be issued and paid the said several sums for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor by any warrant or order in writing under his hand and directed to the Treasurer or other lawful authority may from time to time order and direct, and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the said funds respectively; but the said Treasurer shall not be held liable for any claims which may arise in connection with any of the State Departments transferred to the Commonwealth on or after the date of such transfer.

Treasurer or lawful authority shall be allowed credit for moneys paid by them.

39. The said Treasurer or other lawful authority shall in their respective accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum or sums of money paid by him or them in pursuance of such warrant or order in writing as aforesaid, and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer or other lawful authority in passing the said accounts for any such sums as may be therein mentioned, and he or they shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
