**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

THE object of this Bill is to permit the appointment of the chairman of the Electricity Authority of New South Wales for a term of office of less than seven years.

The Bill—

- (a) removes the requirement that a chairman of the Electricity Authority of New South Wales be appointed for a term of seven years;
- (b) permits the appointment of a chairman for a term not exceeding seven years; and
- (c) makes a provision of a consequential and transitional character.
