EXPLANATORY NOTE

1. Clause 1 specifies the short title of the enacted Bill.
2. Clause 2 is a commencement provision.
3. Clause 3 increases the fees payable for licenses under the Liquor Act, 1912, and the equivalent permits and certificates of registration under that Act.
4. Clause 4 corrects certain incorrect references in the Liquor Act, 1912.
