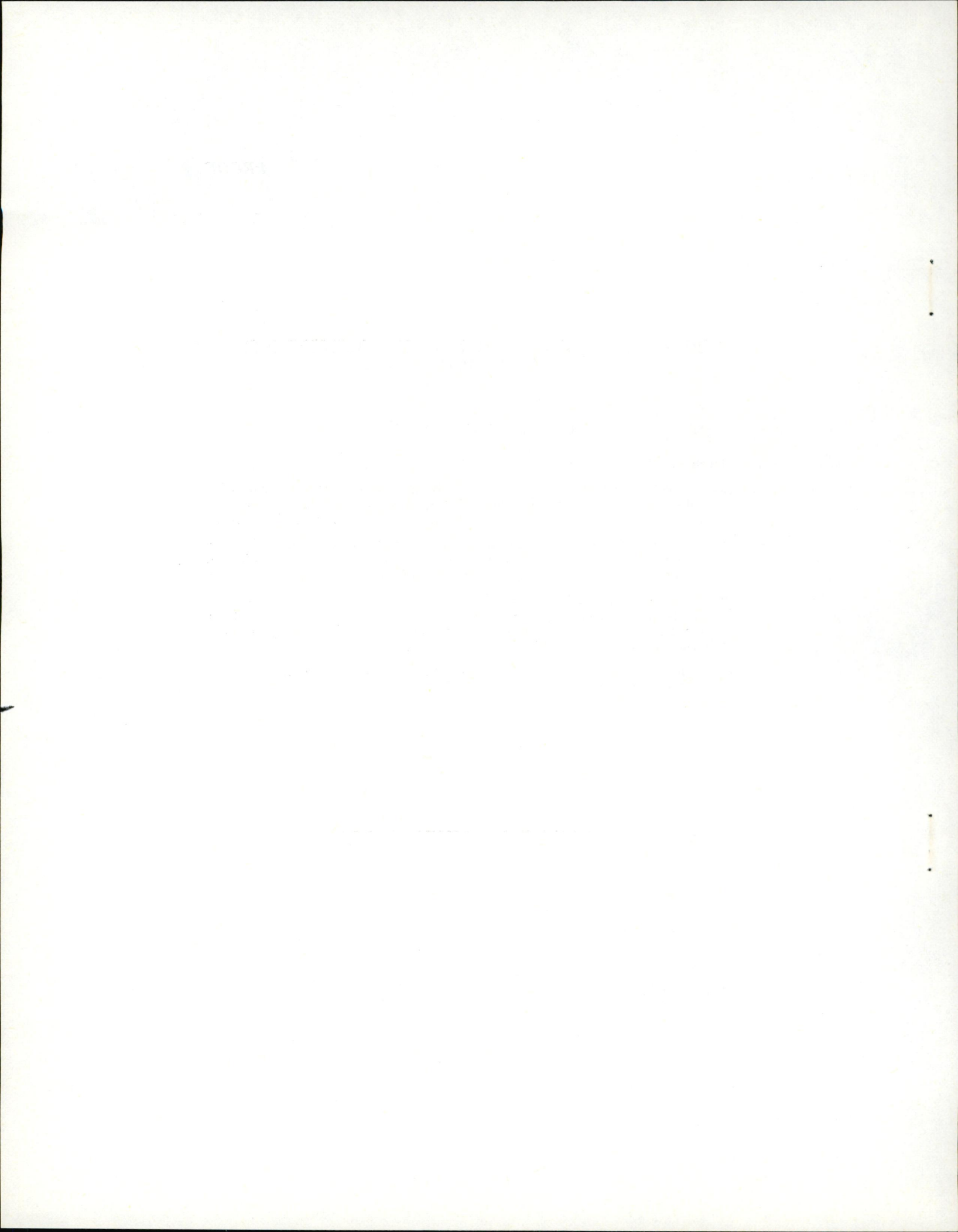

**PUBLIC TRANSPORT COMMISSION (AMENDMENT)
BILL, 1976**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to enable the Governor to cancel the balance of the term of office of a full-time commissioner of the Public Transport Commission and to re-appoint him without loss of service for a further term of office not exceeding 7 years;
 - (b) to enable the Governor to fill a casual vacancy in the office of such a full-time commissioner by appointing a person for a term not exceeding 7 years instead of for the balance of his predecessor's term of office;
 - (c) to enable such a full-time commissioner who, before he became a commissioner was a member of a statutory body, to return to the service of the Government on vacating his office as a commissioner and failing to secure re-appointment to that office;
 - (d) to make provisions consequential upon or ancillary to the foregoing.

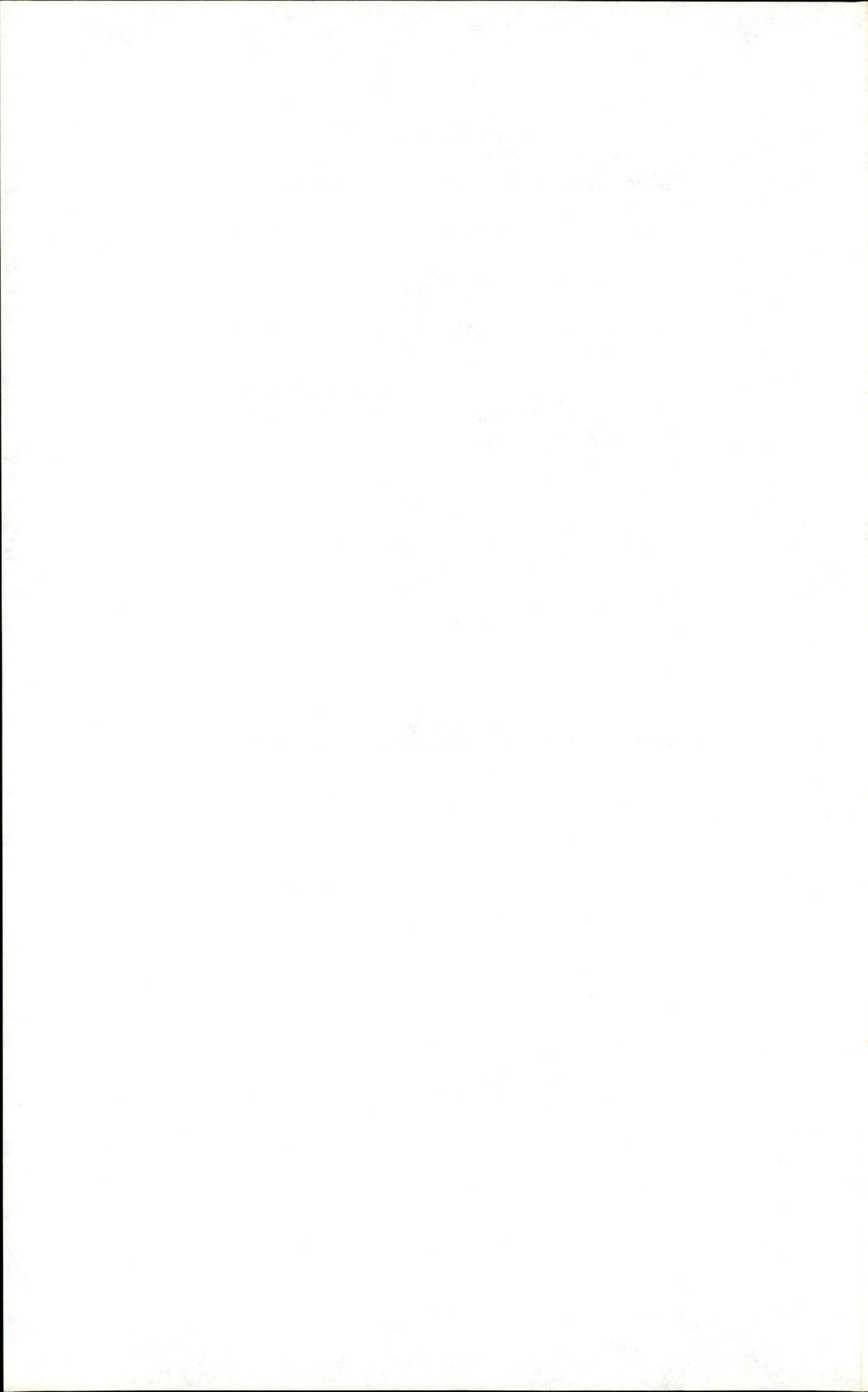
