EXPLANATORY NOTE

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to enable inspectors appointed under the Radioactive Substances Act, 1957, to test irradiating apparatus (clause 3 (a));
 - (b) to prohibit, subject to exemptions prescribed by the regulations, the sale of irradiating apparatus by unlicensed persons (clause 3 (b));
 - (c) to enable licences under the Radioactive Substances Act, 1957, to be granted without payment of fee in certain circumstances (clause 3 (c)); and
 - (d) to enable regulations to be made regulating the sale or purchase of irradiating apparatus (clause 3 (d)).

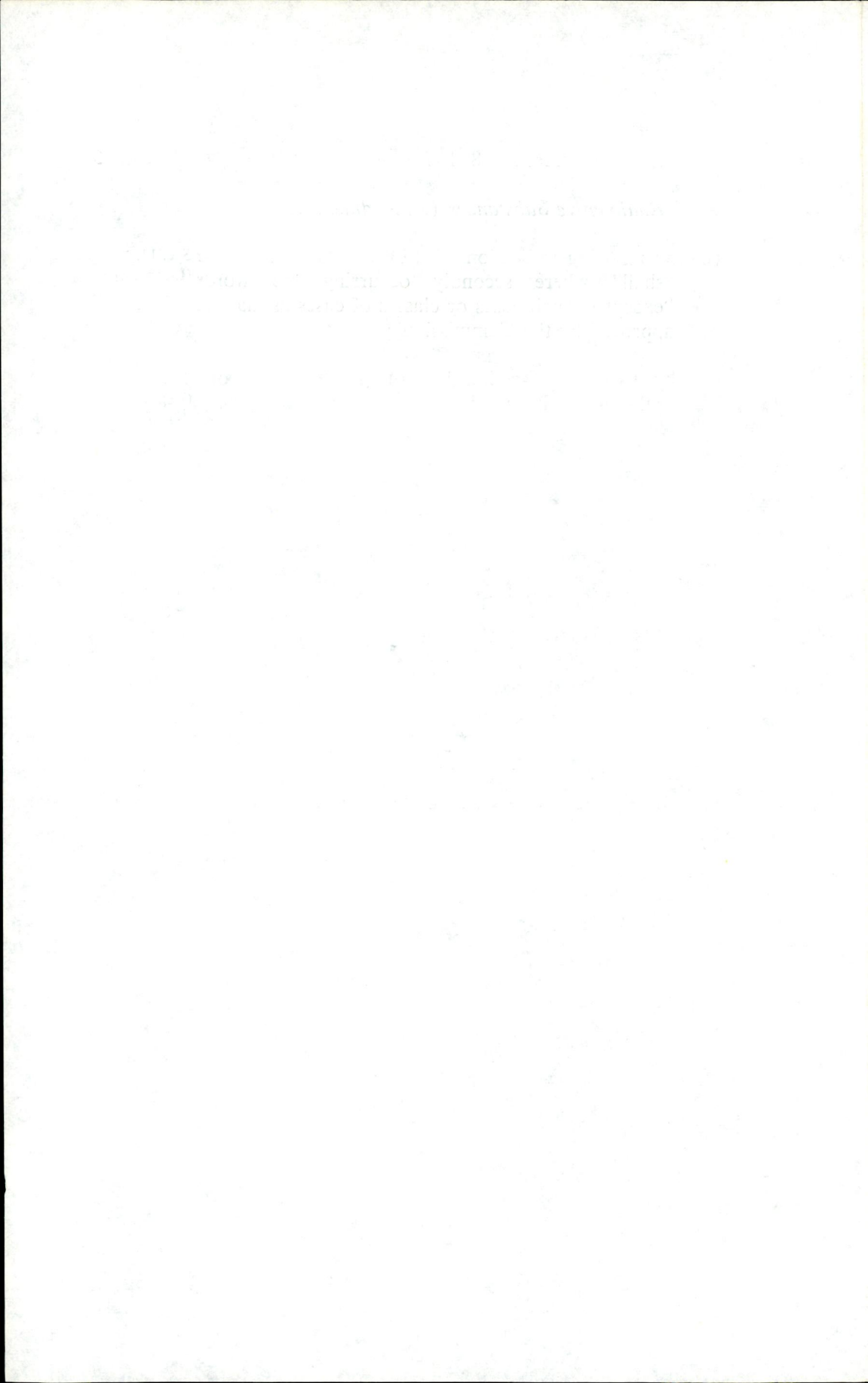
