**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Sydney Farm Produce Market Authority (Amendment) Act, 1974". Short title.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to permit the appointment as part-time members of the Authority persons, not being public servants, who have not attained the age of seventy years;
- (b) to provide that the office of such a part-time member of the Authority becomes vacant when he attains the age of seventy years;
- (c) to make other provisions of a minor or consequential nature.
