### SYDNEY OPERA HOUSE (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1975

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

THE objects of this Bill are to provide for expenditure incurred after 30th June, 1975, on the work sanctioned by the Sydney Opera House Act, 1960, to be financed from the Consolidated Revenue Fund and to permit the net proceeds of certain lotteries to be paid to that Fund in accordance with the State Lotteries Act, 1930.

The Bill contains the following provisions:—

Clause 1. Short title.


Clause 2. Commencement,

Clause 3 provides that a reference in the proposed Act to the "Principal Act" means a reference to the Sydney Opera House Act, 1960.

Clause 4 defines the expression "Opera House Account" for the purposes of the proposed Act.

Clause 5 amends the Principal Act by omitting section 4 (3) (a) which provided that expenditure authorised by that Act was to be paid out of the Opera House Account. The clause inserts a new section 4a in the Principal Act to provide that any such expenditure shall, from the time of commencement of the clause, be paid out of money provided by Parliament. The clause also requires an amount equal to the total amount paid out of the Opera House Account under section 4 (3) (a) of the Principal Act since 30th June, 1975, to be paid into that Account out of money provided under the new section 4a.

Clause 6, which is to commence on a later day than clause 5, amends the Principal Act by omitting section 4 which made provision for and with respect to the Opera House Account (including a provision that the net proceeds of certain lotteries were to be paid into that Account notwithstanding the provisions of the State Lotteries Act, 1930) and makes certain consequential amendments to the long title of that Act. The clause amends the Sydney Opera House Trust Act, 1961, by omitting section 17 (3) which made provision with respect to the application of the Opera House Account and also requires the balance of that Account to be paid into the Consolidated Revenue Fund on the day on which the clause commences.
