DAIRY INDUSTRY (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1977

EXPLANATORY NOTE

THE objects of this Bill are to amend the Dairy Industry Act, 1915—

- (a) by repealing section 17, which prohibits the manufacture of butter and margarine on the same premises;
- (b) by repealing section 22A (6), which requires a condition to be contained in a table margarine license specifying the maximum amount of table margarine which may be manufactured or prepared by the holder of the license during its currency; and
- (c) by repealing section 22A (7) (b) and section 22A (9), which will become redundant on the repeal of section 22A (6).
