

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

**(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)**

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to enable certain dental technicians (hereinafter referred to as “dental prosthetists”) to carry out any work involved in the practice of dental prosthetics and to do certain things ancillary to the practice of dental prosthetics without those dental prosthetists contravening provisions of the Dentists Act, 1934 (Schedule 1 (2) and (3));
  - (b) to enable a dental technician to carry out technical work involved in the practice of dental prosthetics on the written order of a dental prosthetist (Schedule 1 (3)); and
  - (c) to make other provisions of a minor, ancillary or consequential nature.


