An Act to amend the Egg Industry Stabilisation Act, 1971,
in relation to the imposition of quotas on the keeping of
hens by licensed poultry farmers and in certain other
respects.

Egg Industry Stabilisation (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by
and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in
Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
5 follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Egg Industry Stabilisation Short
(Amendment) Act, 1977". title.

2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the Commence-
date of assent to this Act. ment.

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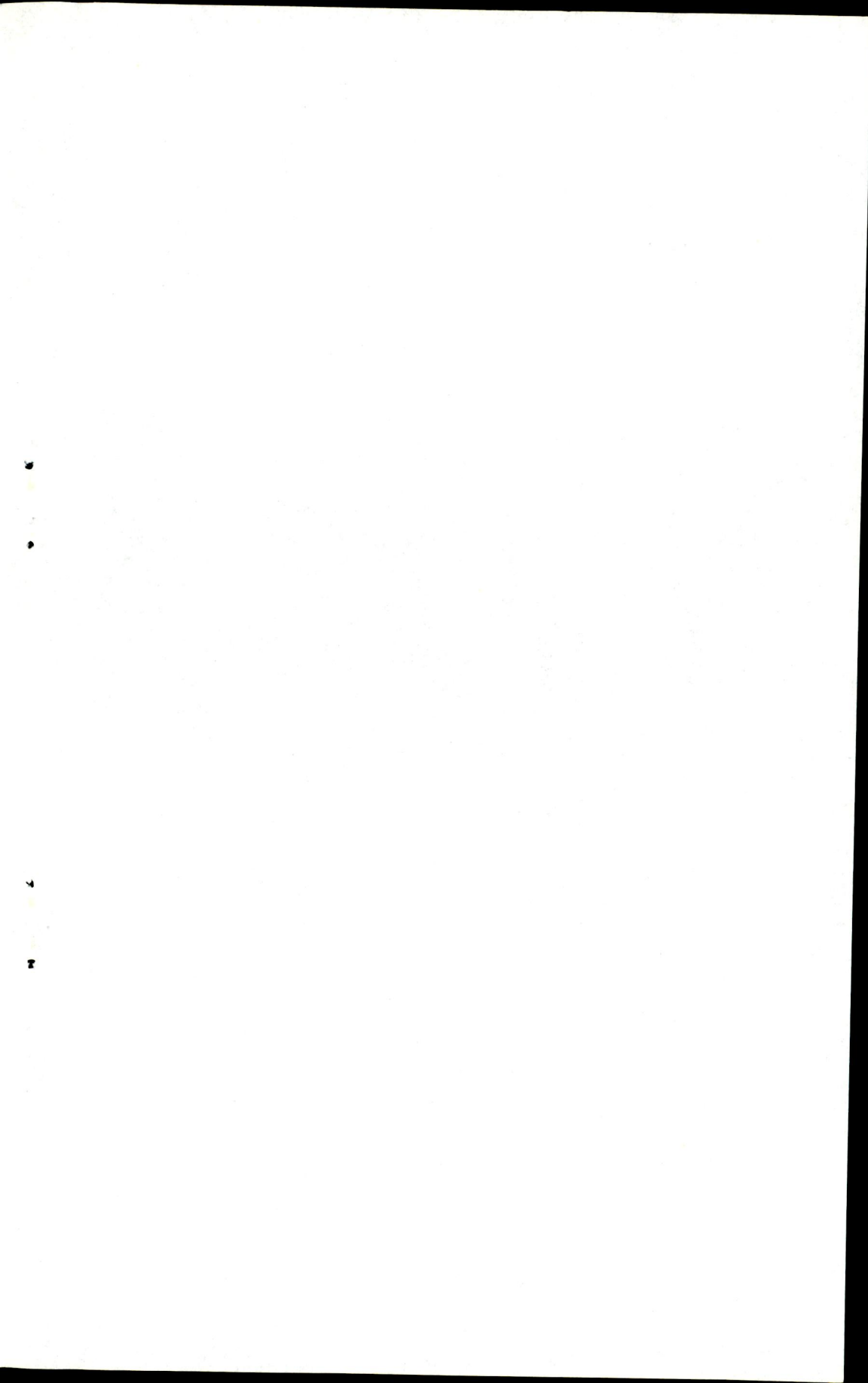
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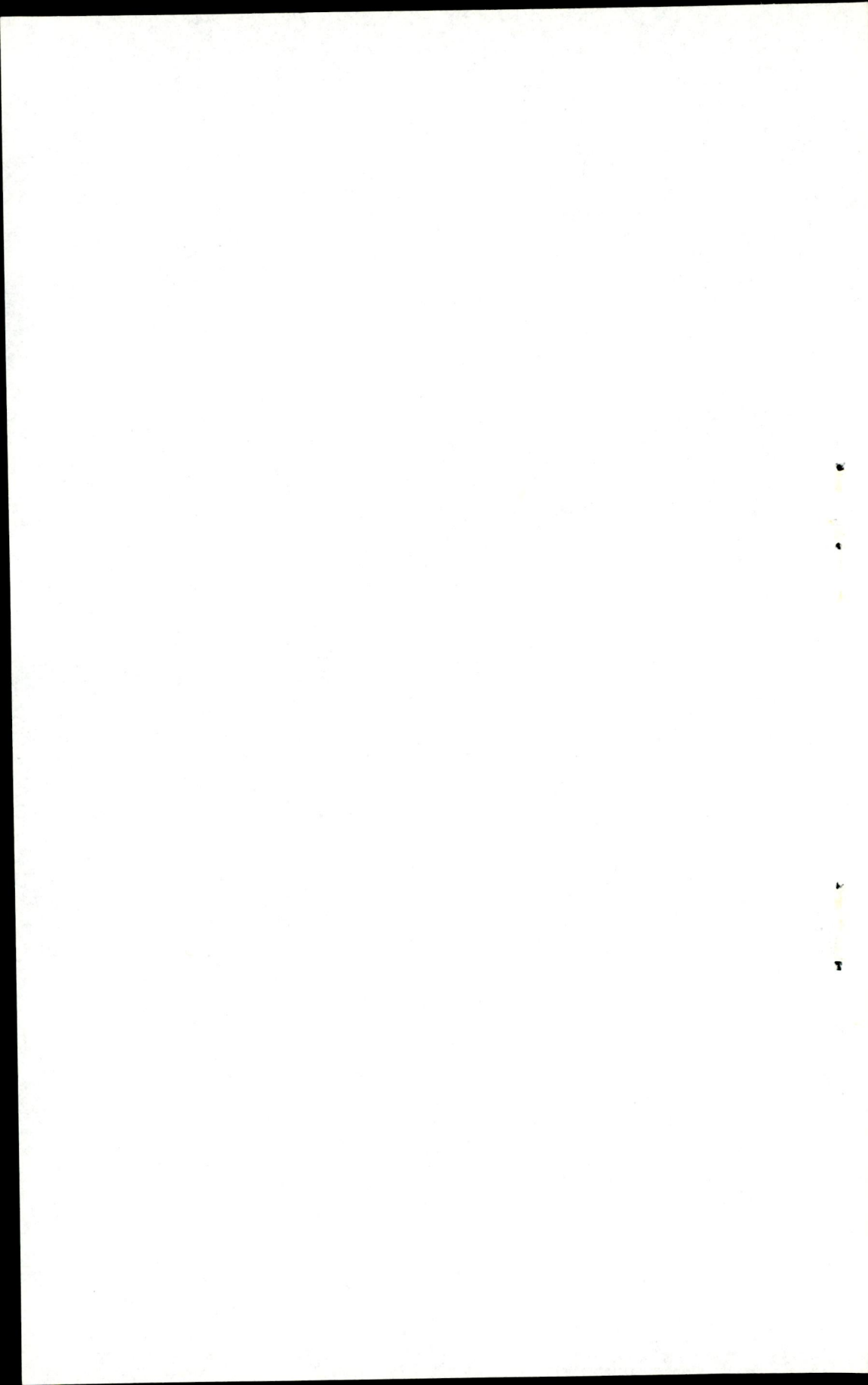
