Government and Betting and Gaming Act

It is the duty of the Government to regulate the betting and gaming industry in the State of Kerala and to ensure that the same is conducted in a fair and equitable manner and to the benefit of the State.

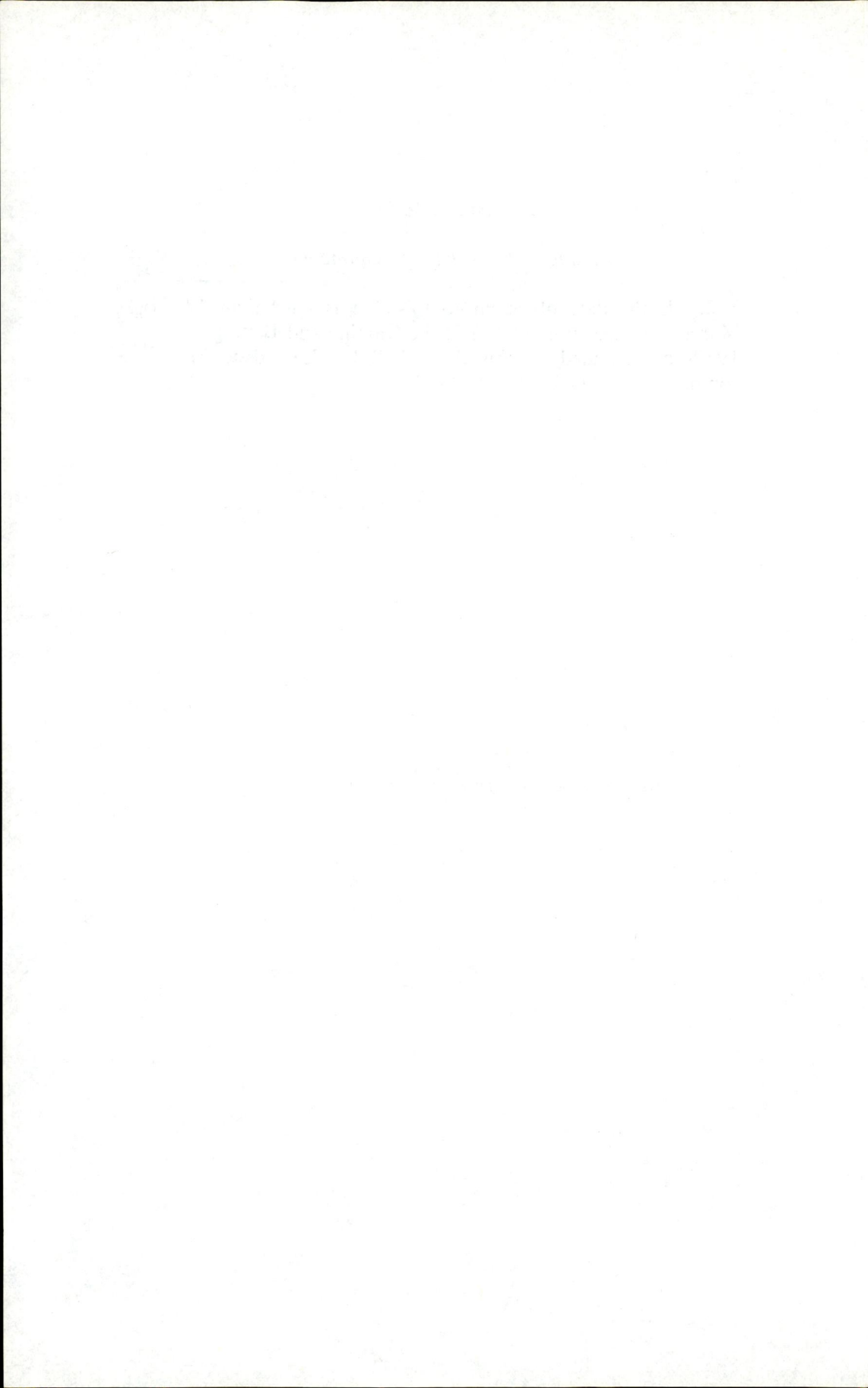
