Cricket and Sports Ground Act, 1977.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

5 **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Government Guarantees (Sydney Cricket and Sports Ground) Amendment Act, 1977". Short title.

2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act. Commencement.

10 (2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Sydney Cricket and Sports Ground Act, 1977.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

THE object of this Bill is to re-enact section 3 (5G) of the Government Guarantees Act, 1934, which authorises the execution of guarantees for the repayment of money borrowed under the legislation relating to the Sydney Cricket and Sports Ground.

The re-enactment is necessary to up-date references to the Sydney Sports Ground and Sydney Cricket Ground Amalgamation Act, 1951, which is proposed to be repealed by the Sydney Cricket and Sports Ground Bill, 1977.
