**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

**(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)**

THE object of this Bill is to amend the Hunter Valley Conservation Trust Act, 1950, to remove the entitlement of public servants and certain other officials to be paid remuneration for their services as trustees of the Hunter Valley Conservation Trust in respect of any period after 30th June, 1973.
