**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

SECTION 14A of the Interpretation Act, 1897, requires the provisions of an Act to be read and construed so that they are not in excess of the legislative powers of the State and the object of this Bill is to extend the operation of that section to instruments (e.g. regulations) made under an Act.

EXPLANATION

Section 1 of the Act provides for the insertion of new members in the Council of States and the House of Representatives. The provisions of the Act shall apply to the members of the Council of States and the House of Representatives who are elected to office on or after the commencement of this Act.
