EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to enable the Library Council of New South Wales (hereinafter called "the Library Council") to establish and maintain investment pools and to provide for the distribution of income of those investment pools (Schedule 1 (2));
 - (b) to provide for the settlement, by arbitration, of disputes arising between local government authorities out of agreements for the provision of libraries, library services and information services by one local government authority in the area of another local government authority (Schedule 1 (5));
 - (c) to vary the membership of the Library Council (Schedule 1 (8)); and
 - (d) to make other amendments of a minor, a consequential or an ancillary nature and for the purposes of statute law revision.

LIBRARY (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1977

EXPLANATORY NOTES

(This Explanation has been added to the Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The object of the Bill is—

- (a) to enable the Library Council of New South Wales (hereinafter called "the Library Council") to establish and maintain investment pools and to provide for the distribution of income of those investment pools (Schedule 1 (1));
- (b) to provide for the establishment by resolution of the Council of a library advisory committee and for the making of agreements for the provision of library services and information services by the local government most suitable in the area of another local government authority (Schedule 1 (2));

(5) It shall be a term of every agreement made under this section, whether the agreement is made before or after the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Library (Amendment) Act, 1977, that any dispute arising under the agreement shall, on the application to the Council of a party to that agreement, be settled by arbitration by an arbitrator appointed by the Council.
