Local Government (Meat Industry) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

5 **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Local Government (Meat Industry) Amendment Act, 1977". Short title.

2. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), this Act shall commence upon the date of assent to this Act. Commencement.

(2) Section 3 shall commence upon the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Meat Industry Act, 1977.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Meat Industry Bill, 1977.

The objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to include in section 10 a reference to the proposed Meat Industry Act, 1977, so that the provisions of that Act prevail;
 - (b) to include in section 654 a reference to the Meat Industry Authority, so that the dispute provisions of section 654 apply to disputes with the Authority.
