This Bill is cognate with the Meat Industry Bill, 1977.

The objects of this Bill are-

- (a) to include in section 10 a reference to the proposed Meat Industry Act, 1977, so that the provisions of that Act prevail;
- (b) to include in section 654 a reference to the Meat Industry Authority, so that the dispute provisions of section 654 apply to disputes with the Authority.
