

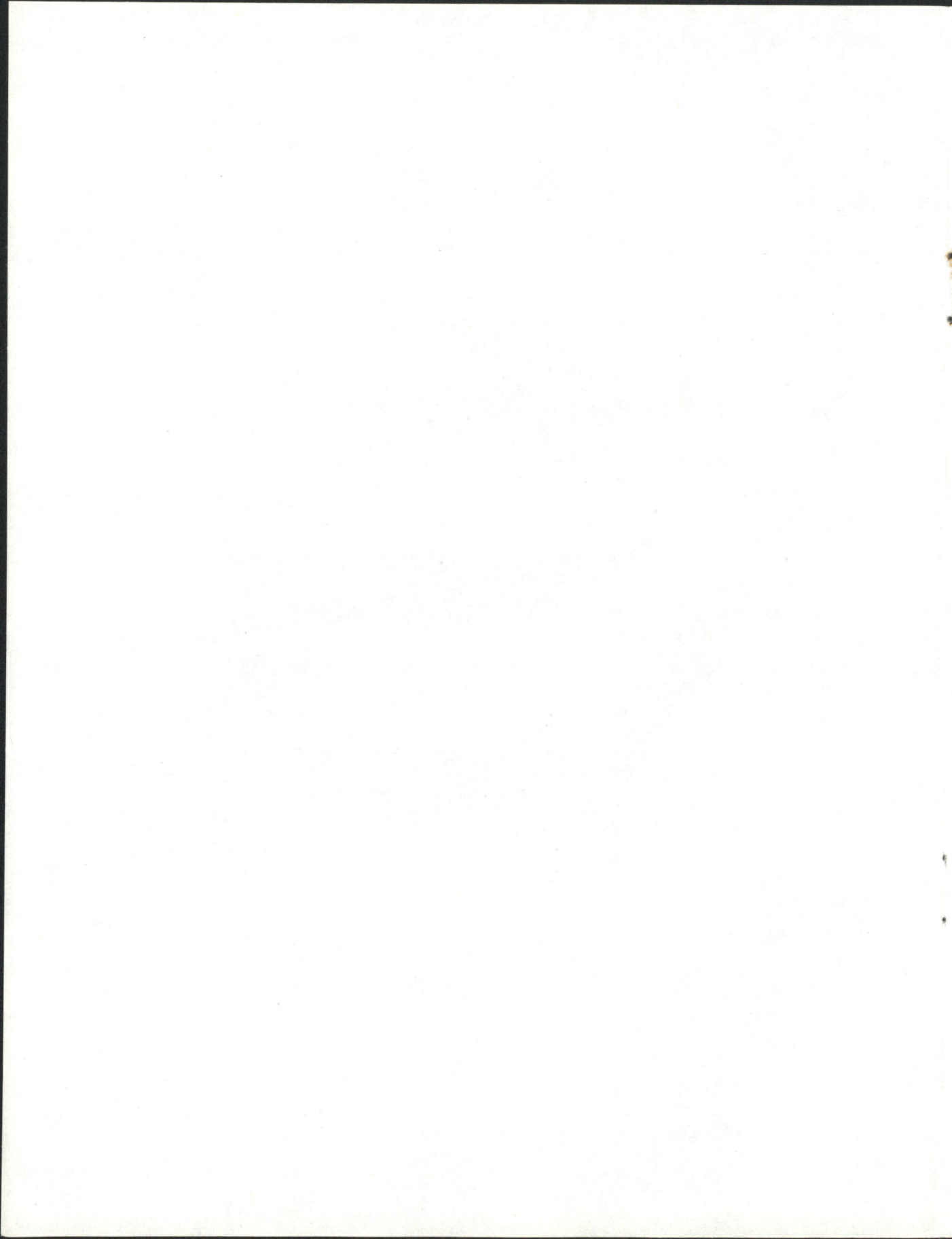

LOTTERIES AND ART UNIONS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1978

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to enable clubs registered under Part X of the Liquor Act, 1912, or Part IIIA of the Gaming and Betting Act, 1912, to conduct certain games of chance (e.g., housie) subject to certain conditions, including conditions—
 - (i) that a permit be obtained from the Minister;
 - (ii) that no charge is made for participating in the games;
 - (iii) that no money prizes are awarded;
 - (iv) that no prizes shall consist of or include spirituous or fermented liquors or tobacco in any form; and
 - (v) that the games only be conducted on the days and at the times specified in the permit (Schedule 1 (1));
 - (b) to make certain amendments to the Lotteries and Art Unions Act, 1901, by way of statute law revision (Schedule 2); and
 - (c) to make other provisions of a minor, consequential or ancillary nature.

Lotteries and Art Unions (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

5 **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Lotteries and Art Unions Short title. (Amendment) Act, 1978".

2. (1) Except as provided in subsections (2) and (3), this Act shall commence on the date of assent to this Act. Commence-
ment.

10 (2) Section 4 shall, in its application to a provision of Schedules 1 and 2, commence on the day on which that provision commences.

(3) Schedule 1 shall commence on such day as may be appointed by the Governor in respect thereof and as may be notified by proclamation published in the Gazette.

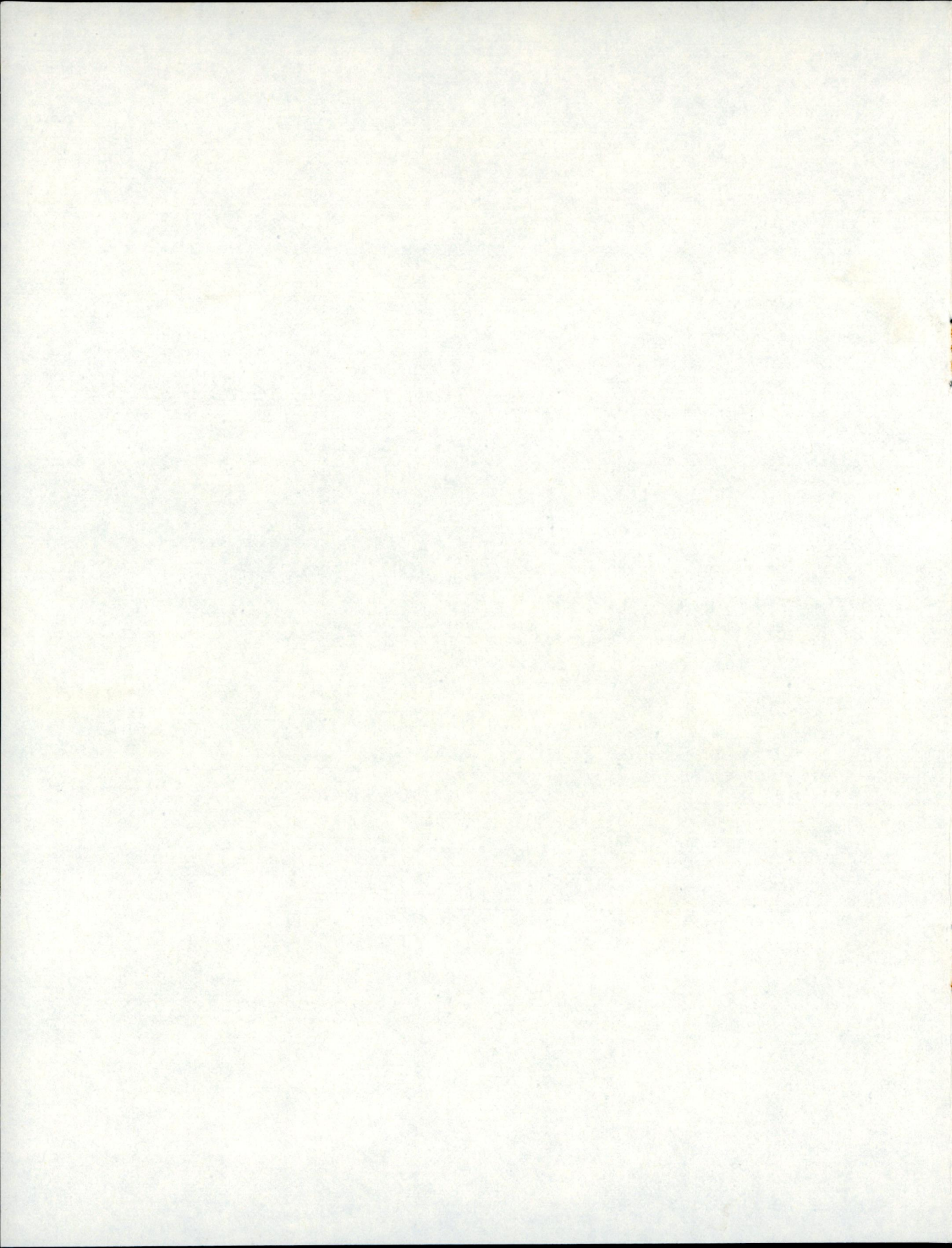

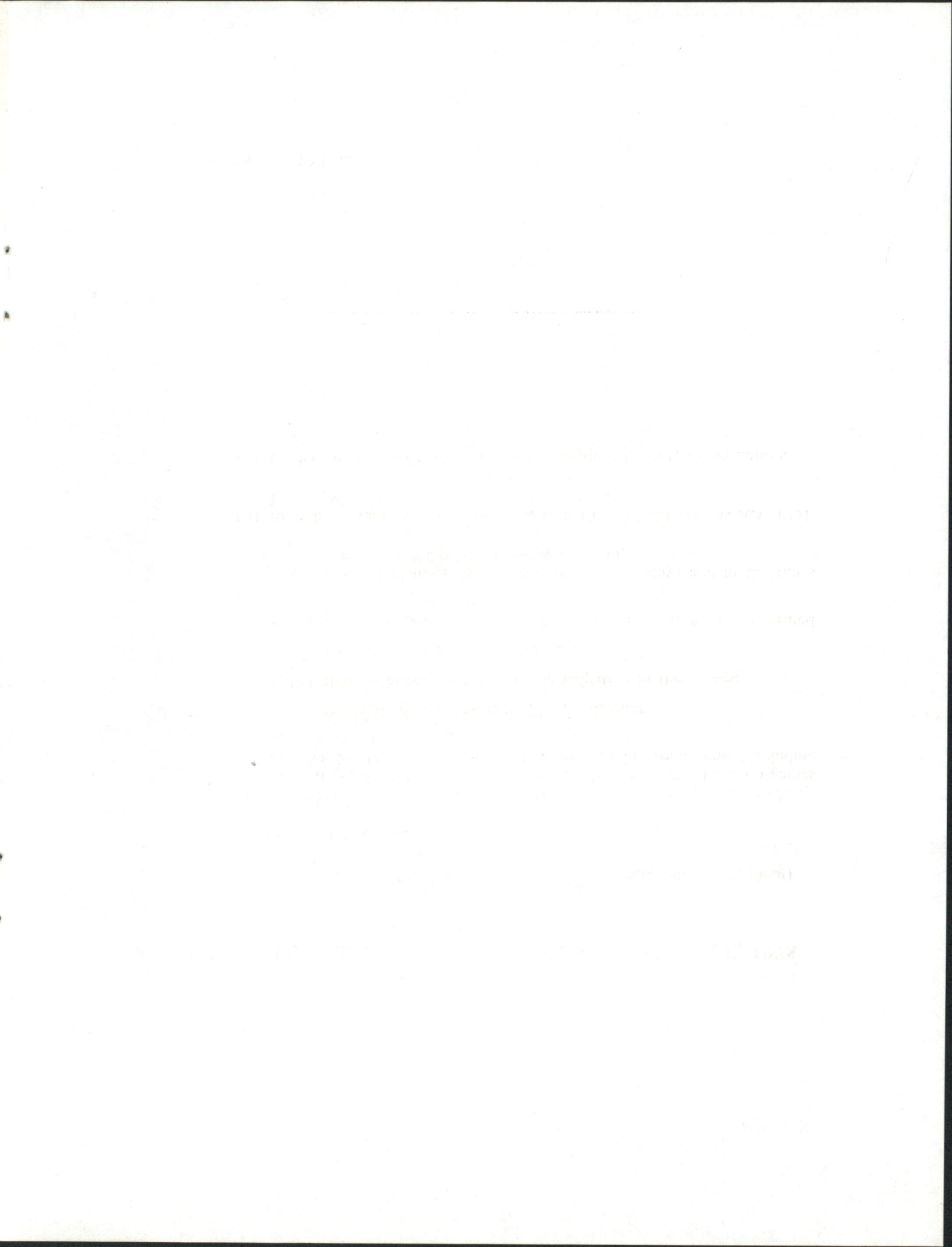

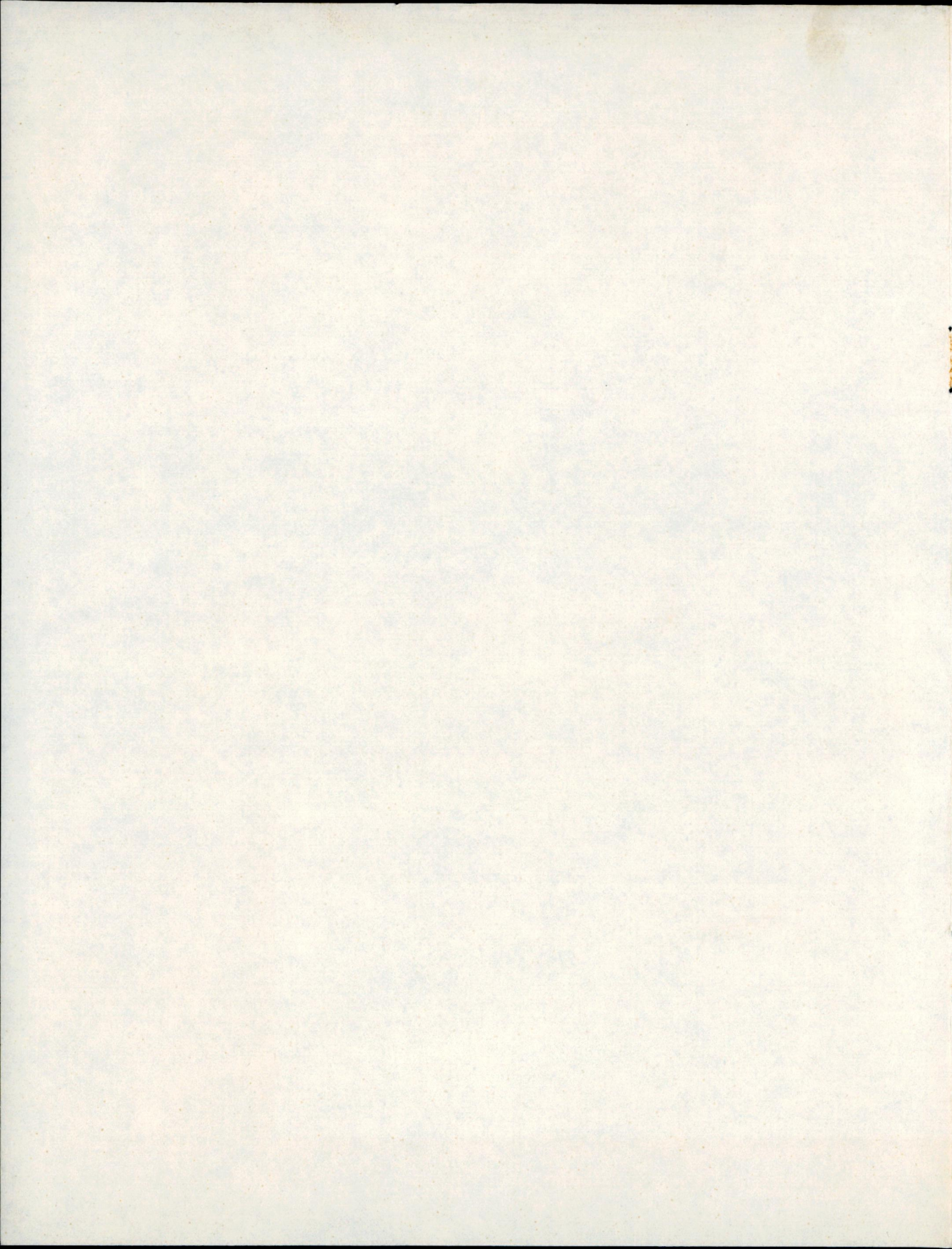
