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### EXPLANATORY NOTE

**(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)**

The objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to remove provisions in the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Act, 1942, relating to the giving of notice of action to an authorised insurer and to the nominal defendant (clause 3 (a) and (b) (i)); and
- (b) to correct a reference to an Act amended by the Notice of Action and Other Privileges Abolition Act, 1977 (clause 3 (b) (ii)).

The amendments made by the proposed Act are to take effect retrospectively from the date of commencement of the Notice of Action and Other Privileges Abolition Act, 1977.

### THE HISTORY NOTE

(This statement is a summary of the Bill as introduced in the Indian Act.)

The Bill is intended to amend the Motor Vehicle Act (R.S.C. 1970, c. 34) and to provide for the regulation of motor vehicles and their drivers.
