An Act to amend section 3 of the Oaths Act, 1900, to enable certain oaths to be taken and subscribed before a member of the Industrial Commission of New South Wales.

BE

Oaths (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

An Act to amend section 3 of the Oaths Act, 1900, to enable certain oaths to be taken and subscribed before a member of the Industrial Commission of New South Wales. [Assented to, 20th February, 1978.]

Oaths (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—
