

**PARLIAMENTARY PAPERS (SUPPLEMENTARY

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

THE object of this Bill is to extend the application of the Parliamentary Papers (Supplementary Provisions) Act, 1975, to a joint sitting of the Members of the Legislative Assembly and Legislative Council held for the purposes of the election of a person to fill a vacant seat in the Legislative Council, as reconstituted by the Constitution and Parliamentary Electorates and Elections (Amendment) Act, 1978.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This explanatory note relates to the Bill as introduced into Parliament.

The object of the Bill is to extend the application of the Parliamentary Papers Act, 1963, to a further number of the Ministers of the Crown. The Bill also extends the definition of the expression "Parliamentary Paper" in the said Act to include a paper in which a statement made in the Legislative Council is contained for the purpose of the Bill.
