ARTICLE I

Section 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors in that State.

Section 3. The Senate shall be composed of two Senators from each State, chosen by the Legislature thereof, for six Years; and each Senator shall have the Qualifications requisite for Senators in that State.

Section 4. The Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors in that State.

Section 5. The House of Representatives shall chuse their Speaker and other Officers; and shall have the sole Power of Impeachment.

Section 6. The Senate shall have the sole and exclusive Power of trying all Impeachments.

Section 7. The Senate shall have the sole and exclusive Power of confirming and rejecting all Appointments of Officers of the United States.

Section 8. The President shall have the Power to nominate and by and with the Advice and Consent of the Senate to appoint and remove Judges of the Supreme Court, and other Officers of the United States.

Section 9. The President shall have the Power to grant Reprieves and Pardons for all Offenses against the United States, except in Cases of Impeachment.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to remove doubt as to the retrospective validation of certain regulations purporting to have been made under the Poisons Act, 1966 (clause 3);
 - (b) to repeal section 5 of and Schedule 4 to the Poisons (Amendment) Act, 1977, those provisions becoming unnecessary upon the enactment of the provision referred to in paragraph (a) (clause 4); and
 - (c) to make other provisions of a minor or consequential character.
