Technical and Further Education (Amendment).

**TECHNICAL AND FURTHER EDUCATION (AMENDMENT)
BILL, 1976**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

THE object of this Bill is to remove the present statutory basis for the Department of Technical and Further Education, and to place it in the same position as other Departments, so far as concerns its future existence and title.

The Bill contains the following provisions :—

Clause 1. Short title.

Clause 2 repeals section 6 of the Technical and Further Education Act, 1974, which constitutes the Department of Technical and Further Education.

Clause 3 provides for the continuance, subject to clause 4, of the Department of Technical and Further Education.

Clause 4 provides that nothing in the proposed Act affects any power to establish, abolish, or change the title of any Department.
