**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to increase from 25 cents to 50 cents the unit of investment in respect of off-course win and place totalizators (Schedule 1 (4));
  - (b) to enable the Totalizator Agency Board, with the approval of the Minister, to allow advertising (other than the advertising of cigarettes or other tobacco products) on premises and on stationery or other matter used by the Board (Schedule 1 (5));
  - (c) to provide that income of the Totalizator Agency Board, the application of which is not otherwise provided for, shall be applied in the same way as commission received by the Board (Schedule 1 (2)); and
  - (d) to make other provisions of a minor, consequential or ancillary nature.
