Act No. 91, 1978.

An Act to amend the University of Wollongong Act, 1972, with respect to the election of a member of the Legislative Council as a member of the Council of the University of Wollongong. [Assented to, 11th September, 1978.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "University of Wollongong (Constitution) Amendment Act, 1978".

Commencement.

- 2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.
- (2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the first appointed day.
- (3) In subsection (2), "first appointed day" has the meaning ascribed thereto by section 16 of the Constitution Act, 1902.

Amendment of Act No. 72, 1972.

Sec. 15. (Constitution of Council other than first Council.)

Sec. 16. (Vacation of office.)

- 3. The University of Wollongong Act, 1972, is amended—
  - (a) by omitting section 15 (3) (a) (i) and by inserting instead the following subparagraph:—
    - (i) as soon as practicable after each periodic Council election within the meaning of section 3 of the Constitution Act, 1902; or
  - (b) (i) by omitting section 16 (h) and by inserting instead the following paragraph:—
    - (h) ceases, in the case of the parliamentary member elected by the Legislative Council—
      - (i) to be a member of that Council otherwise than by reason of section 22B (1) (c) of the Constitution Act, 1902; or

- (ii) to be a member of that Council by reason of section 22B (1) (c) of that Act and does not become a candidate at the next periodic Council election within the meaning of section 3 of that Act or, as the case may be, becomes a candidate but is not elected;
- (ii) by omitting section 16 (i) (ii) and by inserting instead the following subparagraph:—
  - (ii) to be a member of that Assembly by reason of its dissolution or its expiration by effluxion of time and does not become a candidate at the next general election of members of that Assembly or, as the case may be, becomes a candidate but is not elected; or
- **4.** Notwithstanding section 3, a member of the Council of the Saving. University of Wollongong who was elected by the Legislative Council and who is holding that office immediately before the commencement of that section does not cease to hold that office until—
  - (a) the Legislative Council elects one of its members to replace him; or
  - (b) he ceases to hold that office pursuant to the University of Wollongong Act, 1972, as in force immediately before that commencement,

whichever first occurs.



# UNIVERSITY OF WOLLONGONG (CONSTITUTION) AMENDMENT BILL, 1978

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

THE object of this Bill is to provide for the election of a member of the Legislative Council to the Council of the University of Wollongong after each concurrent periodic Council election and Assembly general election instead of after the commencement of the term of service of members elected at a triennial Council election as required by section 17F (5) of the Constitution Act, 1902, prior to the reconstitution of the Legislative Council under the Constitution and Parliamentary Electorates and Elections (Amendment) Act, 1978.

### A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the University of Wollongong Act, 1972, with respect to the election of a member of the Legislative Council as a member of the Council of the University of Wollongong.

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- Notwithstanding section 3, a member of the Council of the Saving.
