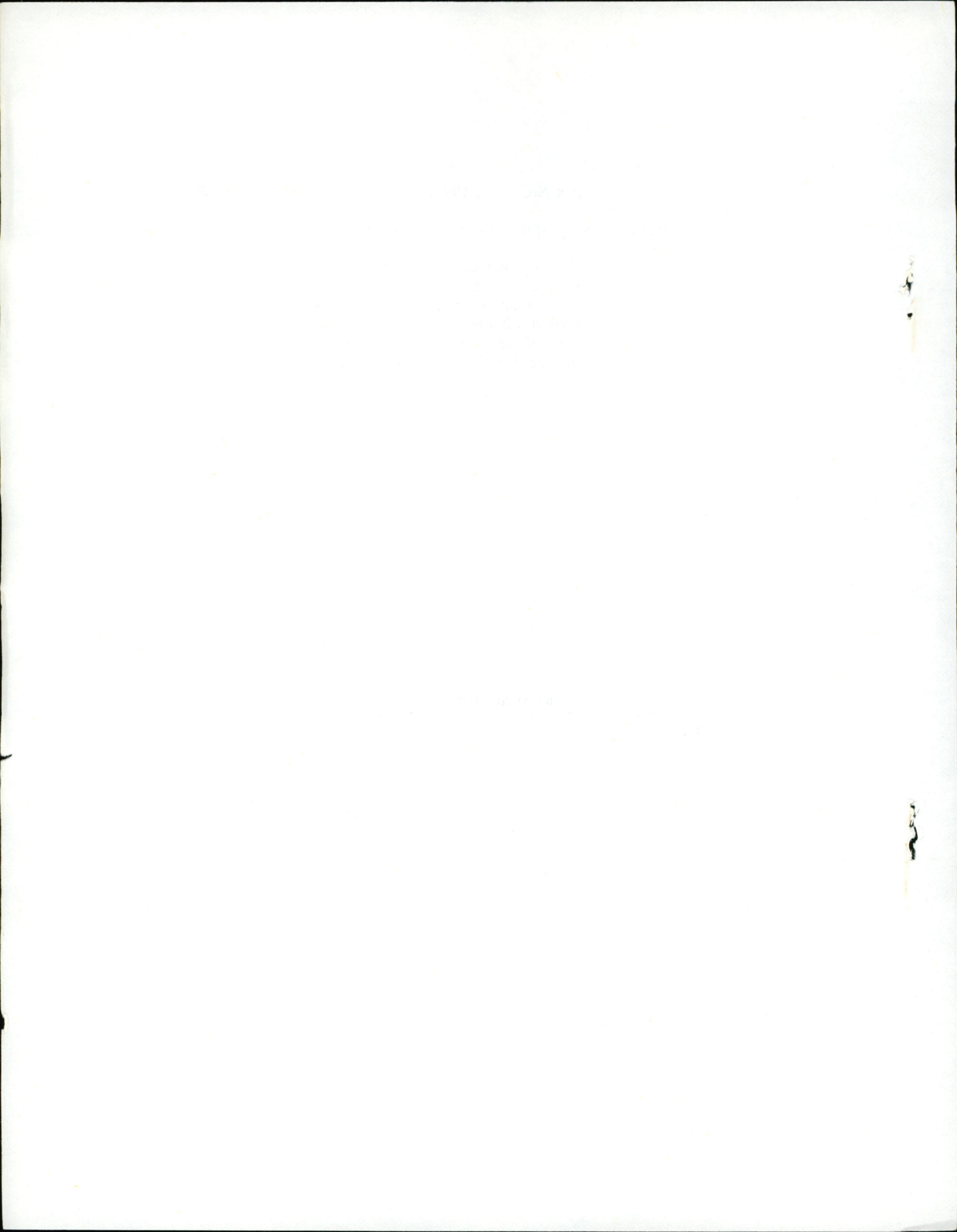

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

THE object of this Bill is to amend the definition of "wheat products" in section 4 of the Wheat Industry Stabilization Act, 1974, to include as wheat products not only a commodity produced mainly from other wheat products or from wheat, but also a commodity produced partly from other wheat products or from wheat if that commodity is declared by regulations made under the Wheat Export Charge Act 1974 of the Parliament of the Commonwealth to be a wheat product for the purposes of that Commonwealth Act.

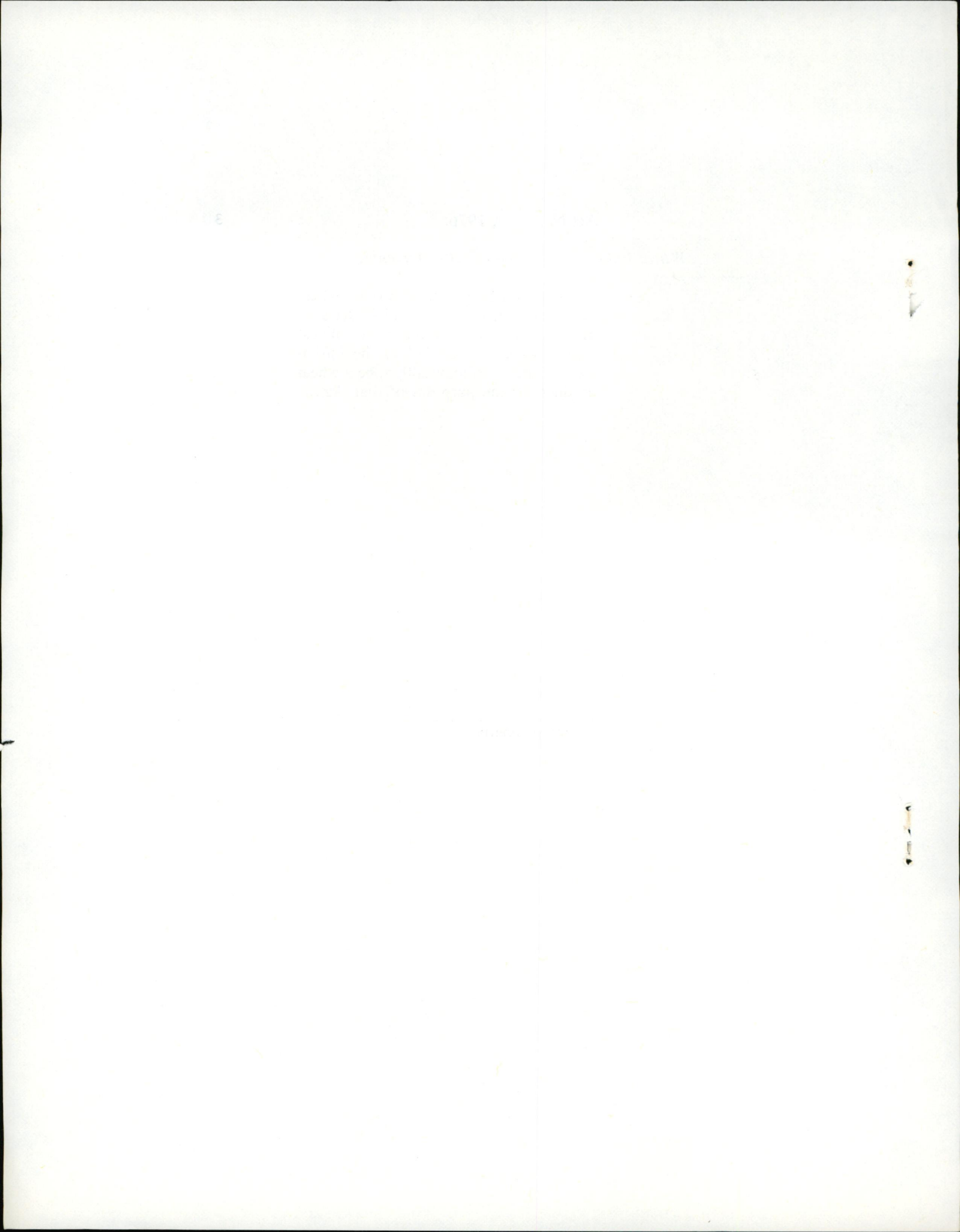
