**YOUTH AND COMMUNITY SERVICES (AMENDMENT)
BILL, 1976**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

THE object of this Bill is to remove the present statutory basis for the Department of Youth and Community Services, and to place it in the same position as other Departments, so far as concerns its future existence and title.

The Bill contains the following provisions :—

Clause 1. Short title.

Clause 2 repeals section 4 of the Youth and Community Services Act, 1973, which provides for a Department to be known as the Department of Youth and Community Services.

Clause 3 provides for the continuance, subject to clause 4, of the Department of Youth and Community Services.

Clause 4 provides that nothing in the proposed Act affects any power to establish, abolish or change the title of any Department.

YOUTH AND COMMUNITY SERVICES (AMENDMENT)
BILL, 1978

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of the Bill is to amend the Youth and Community Services Act 1978 and to provide for the transfer of certain functions of the Department of Health to the Department of Education and Science.

The Bill does not affect the law in force at the present time.

Section 1 of the Bill is a consequential amendment.

Section 2 amends section 1 of the Youth and Community Services Act 1978 so as to provide for the transfer of certain functions of the Department of Health to the Department of Education and Science.

Section 3 provides for the continuation of the law in force at the present time.
