The objects of this Bill are to extend the operation of certain provisions of the Acts Reprinting Act, 1972, to regulations, rules and by-laws that are made, approved or confirmed by the Governor and to make other provisions of a minor or consequential nature.

An Act to extend the operation of certain provisions of the Acts Reprinting Act, 1972, to certain additional statutory instruments.

Acts Reprinting (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

5 **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Acts Reprinting (Amendment) Act, 1980". Short title.

2. The Acts Reprinting Act, 1972, is amended in the manner set forth in Schedule 1. Amendment of Act No. 48, 1972.

10 **3.** A reference in any Act, instrument made under an Act or other instrument to the Acts Reprinting Act, 1972, shall be construed as a reference to the Reprints Act, 1972. References to Acts Reprinting Act, 1972.

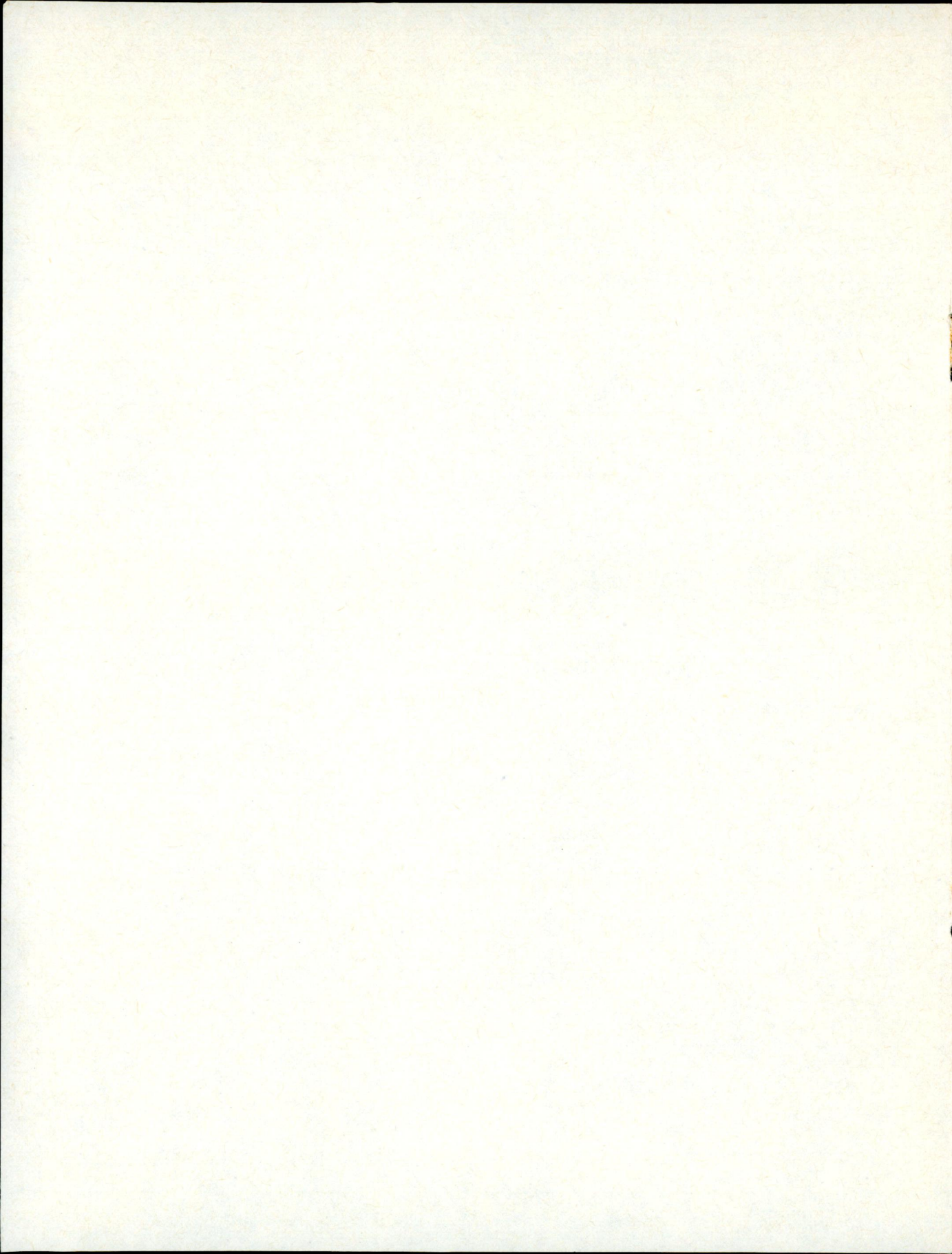

Acts Reprinting (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short title. **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Acts Reprinting (Amendment) Act, 1980".

Amendment of Act No. 48, 1972. **2.** The Acts Reprinting Act, 1972, is amended in the manner set forth in Schedule 1.

References to Acts Reprinting Act, 1972. **3.** A reference in any Act, instrument made under an Act or other instrument to the Acts Reprinting Act, 1972, shall be construed as a reference to the Reprints Act, 1972.
