Act No. 77, 1981.

An Act to amend the Audit Act, 1902, so as to repeal certain provisions relating to the aggregate statement showing the net result of the combined operations of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and certain other undertakings. [Assented to, 1st June, 1981.]

Audit (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Audit (Amendment) Act, 1981".

2. The Audit Act, 1902, is amended in the manner set forth in Schedule 1.

AUDIT (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1981

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Maritime Services (Amendment) Bill, 1981.

The object of this Bill is to repeal section 59A of, and the Ninth Schedule to, the Audit Act, 1902, so that an aggregate statement showing the net result of the combined operations of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales and such other undertakings or activities as the Governor may from time to time direct will no longer be required.
