An Act to amend section 87A of the Broken Hill Water and Sewerage Act, 1938, to extend the class of persons eligible for rating concessions. [Assented to, 10th December, 1980.]

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

**(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)**

This Bill is cognate with the Local Government (Further Amendment) Bill, 1980.

The object of this Bill is to amend section 87A of the Broken Hill Water and Sewerage Act, 1938, to extend the class of persons eligible for rating concessions by including persons who are in receipt of a benefit under Part IV<sup>AAA</sup> of the Commonwealth Social Services Act 1947.
