Builders Licensing (Plumbers, Gasfitters and Drainers) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Builders Licensing (Plumbers, Gasfitters and Drainers) Amendment Act, 1979".

Amendment of Act No. 16, 1971. Sec. 3. (Interpretation.)

2. The Builders Licensing Act, 1971, is amended by omitting from the definition of "trade work" in section 3 (1) the words "granted under that other Act or that regulation" and by inserting instead the words "or other instrument granted under that or any other Act or any regulation".
