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**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

**(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)**

This Bill is cognate with the Securities Industry (Corporate Affairs Commission) Amendment Bill, 1979.

The Corporate Affairs Commission is being reconstituted and the object of this Bill is to make a consequential amendment to the Business Names Act, 1962.

**An Act to amend the Business Names Act, 1962, in consequence  
of the reconstitution of the Corporate Affairs Commission.**

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*Business Names (Corporate Affairs Commission) Amendment.*

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

5   **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Business Names (Corporate Affairs Commission) Amendment Act, 1979". Short title.

**2.** (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act. Commencement.

10       (2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Securities Industry (Corporate Affairs Commission) Amendment Act, 1979.

**3.** The Business Names Act, 1962, is amended— Amendment of Act

(a) by omitting from section 3 (4) the words "Registrar under this Act" and by inserting instead "Corporate Affairs Commission"; No. 11, 1962. Sec. 3. (Repeal, and savings and transitional provisions.)

(b) by omitting from section 4 (1) the definition of "Commissioner". Sec. 4. (Interpretation.)
